General Maintenance

- a. Positioning of latch on door between porch and front hall still giving problems. This will be re-addressed
- b. Once again the timer on the cooker has prevented a hirer using the cooker in manual mode. It is not a system that many people will know. The symbols on the clock are very small and it only needs a small turn of one knob to change it into 'timed' mode. A sign has been posted on the cooker to advise hirers not to change the clock settings. Hopefully this will result in other hirers not experiencing difficulties.
