BRAKE LIGHTS

What are your meds doing to you?

You may have heard by now that I sold my Goldwing a few weeks ago. Rather an odd thing to do when you're 50 years old; that's the age where most folks are <u>buying</u> a Goldwing. It was not an easy decision to make, but it's not good to just let a bike sit. So then the new question is - Why would I let it sit?


About 10 years ago, I began to notice I had sensitive teeth. Hot/cold drinks, hard foods, all made my teeth hurt on the left side. Man I was going to need some serious crown work it seemed. Two years ago, I started having massive flash pains, not only in my teeth now, but in the entire left side of my head! Did I crack a tooth? It was crazy painful. Around the holidays of 2014, the seizures started.

Diagnosis? No dental issues. I have Trigeminal Neuralgia, a severe neuropathic chronic pain disorder affecting a three-branched nerve that carries sensations from the face to the brain and controls facial motor functions such as biting and chewing. Long story short – a failing nerve was sending bad info to my brain. My face felt like it was being removed with a road grader and a welding torch, in seizures that lasted from a few seconds to several minutes, repeating several times an hour. On a 1-10 scale, the pain is rated 13, and the condition used to be called the Suicide Disease, as that was the end result for most patients long ago. It would leave me non-functional with blurred vision.

Lucky for us in modern medicine, there's a pill for this. I take Gabapentin, which is a flavor of Neurontin. Works pretty good – takes away the seizures and leaves just a hint of pain, feeling like a mild ear infection 24x7. Relief!! Oh by the way, there is no free lunch – it also brings dizziness. A major side effect in my case; any orientation changes (stand up, turn around quick, even turn my head quick) makes the world spin momentarily, and I sometimes grab for something to hang on. This is not a good side effect with a 900-pound motorcycle! So I waited... and waited, as here is the key to this article folks:

Medications can have side effects. If these effects are still there after 6 months, the effects are very likely yours to keep; a gift that keeps on giving. *Listen up!* Any medication changes should be closely monitored for side effects, and you should pay particular attention to impacts on your motorcycle handling abilities. Google for potential side effects, or ask your doctor. If you feel any side effects, tell your doctor and do some analysis together. For me, after a year, it became ever clearer that 900-pound two-wheel bikes were not a good idea for me anymore. I've heard trikes are nice...hmmm....

Chapter U Rider Ed

How Are You Starting This Riding Season?

Winter is finally gone, so let the riding season begin! Maybe you have recently taken a CPR/First Aid class or a seminar or two during this past off-season. This means you are better prepared to help in case one of your riding buddies has an accident or a health issue, or you are prepared to be a better co-rider. Now you are available to spend more time riding now that the season is here. Hopefully you have also taken time to make sure your motorcycle is ready to go, too. You may have done a T-CLOCS, or changed the oil, replaced worn tires, kept your battery charged, or discovered that you needed a new one and replaced it.

There are other things that you can do to be at your best out on the road, too. Many of us will be out on the road before MSF or GWRRA Rider Courses are offered. So what else can you do to get in the right frame of mind and tune up your skills right away? There are a few things you can do as an individual or in a group (such as with your fellow chapter members) to be prepared to ride safely and with skill before the season is even two weeks old.

First, you can practice your skills in an empty, quiet parking lot with smooth pavement that is free of loose gravel or sand. Find an empty church or a school parking lot, or some unused out-of-the-way space at a shopping center safely away from moving vehicles. Choose a time when it is unlikely to be busy, (e.g., a school lot on Sunday) as your safety is of the utmost importance.

Work on braking, turning, curves, stopping while in a curve (remember to straighten the handlebars before braking!), and turning when pulling away from a stop. When you practice alone, always remain vigilant to vehicles encroaching on your space.

Second, how about participating in a Parking Lot Practice? Also referred to as a PLP, this is an activity that many Chapters hold at the chapter level. The exercises in a PLP are all spelled out in the Cornering Practice Guide along with tips to execute the skills correctly. Talk to your Chapter Educator about holding a Parking Lot Practice for your chapter, or if there is a



Facilitated Parking Lot Practice scheduled near you. **GWRRA is doing away with this technique.**They can no longer be used to renew Rider Ed courses. I am working with the District Rider Educator to implement a Rider Ed course here in the Dothan area. Keep tuned for more details.

Third, you can attend a Team Riding Seminar. This Rider Ed seminar is available for presentation at your chapter, and may be available at some District rallies. This seminar is particularly good

to hold at your chapter because the folks who are normally part of your riding team can all hear the same Team Riding tips. Why would you sit through a Team Riding Seminar? One reason is because most of us ride to various places around the state with our riding friends. And if you know what to expect from the others in your group – your team – you will be more likely to trust them. You will trust them because you'll know they are all going to ride safely and predictably in a staggered formation. That is what the Team Riding Seminar provides you. Several in our chapter attended a Team Riding Seminar during the Alabama District Rally.



Getting back to the bike for a minute, if you have new tires on your bike for the new season, know that the tire manufacturers recommend that you take it easy on those tires for the first 50 – 100 miles. That means go easy in the curves and easy on acceleration to prevent slide-outs. The reason is because the surface of the tire will be slickest (slippery) when new. There are a couple of common explanations why, but the result is the same – reduced traction. The rubber will get scuffed and roughed up enough over that distance during normal riding and the tire's grip will improve. Be particularly careful with new tires on painted stripes and metal

plates, and all surfaces that are slick even when your tires aren't.

Remember that practice in a parking lot, by yourself or with others, is good for all of us after the long off-season. It is even more beneficial and


important if you recently bought a new or used motorcycle. Get to know that new-to-you bike and how it handles in a safe environment. After brushing up your skills, you'll be ready to go out and enjoy a safe riding season!


