

Your Father Is Calling You!

Hello and how are you? Before we go any further I want to ask you some questions. Do you believe in God? Do you believe Jesus Christ is the Son of God? Do you believe Jesus Christ died to save the world? Do you believe Jesus Christ rose from the dead? Do you believe the Bible is the accurate word of God? Finally are you saved, meaning have you accepted Jesus Christ as your Lord and personal Savior?

Hopefully you answered yes to all of the above questions, but if you answered no to any, by the time you've finished reading this booklet we hope you rethink your position.

Gen.1:1 "In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth."

Our first question asks "*Do you believe in God?*" The Bible declares that God is the creator of all things both in heaven and in earth (Gen.1:1). God is the source and origin of all life. One might ask "who created God". This question is easy to answer, but it might be hard to understand.

The first chapter & verse of the Bible declares that..."in the beginning God". The beginning is God according to the Bible. Think of it this way. If you read the very first sentence of a book,

it would be impossible for you to give any information regarding the overall content of the book. You could not tell anyone the beginning, ending, or any other information other than what you read in the first sentence of the book. Apply this logic to the Bible.

The first sentence indicates God is the beginning (Gen.1:1). God is the creator of all things; therefore, He is the sustainer of all life. There was no existence of man before God. God is the first and the last of all things.

The next question involves a man named Jesus Christ. The New Testament of the Bible indicates that Jesus Christ is the Son of the Living God (John 3:16). He is not a myth. History documents Jesus as an actual man that walked the earth doing many miracles. In fact, a Jewish historian named Josephus Flavius mentions Jesus in his historical chronicles of Jerusalem. The only question you have to ask yourself is whether you believe Jesus Christ is the Son of God.

Jesus Christ was born of a virgin woman named Mary in 6th century B.C. (Before Christ). Many ask "*How can a virgin woman give birth to a child?*" The Bible declares that Jesus was conceived by God's Holy Spirit (Luke 1:34-37).

Luke 1:34 Mary said to the angel, How can this be, since I am Virgin?" v:35...the angel answered "The Holy Spirit will come

upon you, and for that reason of the holy offspring shall be called the Son of God. v:37...nothing is impossible with God".

Jesus Christ is God's Son and He was sent 3:16). He preached, healed, and taught God's authority at the age of 33. Crucifixion was a

by God to die for the sins of the world (John will. Jesus was crucified under Roman death penalty sentenced to criminals.

Did Jesus have to die for the sins of the world? Yes! Why did Jesus (the Son of God) come and die for the sins of the world? In the beginning God created the first man Adam. Adam was the very first human being God created and lived in the Garden of Eden.

Gen.2:17 but the tree of knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, ...you eat from it you shall surely die.

God created Adam from the dust of the ground and created the Woman (his wife) with one of his ribs. When God placed Adam in the Garden of Eden, He told him not to eat from the tree of knowledge of good & evil (Gen.2:17). Adam disobeyed God's word or command. The Serpent (the Devil) deceived his wife into eating from the tree. After she ate from the tree she gave some of the fruit to Adam. Since this incident, sin entered into the world and mankind was condemned to death.

Jesus Christ is the Son of God and the Bible classifies Him as the last Adam sent to save mankind from death (1 Cor.15:45). As a result of Adam's disobedience to God's word, all mankind was born in sin. Sin separates Man from God. This is important because God is the source of all life. Therefore, God sent "the last Adam" (Jesus) to atone for the world's sins.

Jesus Christ's death was payment for Adam's sin, your sin, my sin, and all the sin in the world (Mat.26:26-28). As a result of Jesus living a righteous life and giving His life as payment for sin, people can have a relationship with God their Father; **if** one accepts Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior. It's important for a person to accept Christ as their personal Savior and live their life as Christ lived.

John 3:3...unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

Without accepting Jesus Christ's payment for sin it is impossible to please God or call God "Father". Once a person accepts and confesses their sins in Jesus name, God forgives that person instantly of all their sins. This act places a person in good standing with God. The person becomes God's child through God's only Son, Jesus Christ (John 3:3-6).

The next question we must answer is whether or not the Bible is the accurate word of God? Many people try to discredit the Bible because they say man wrote it and changed certain things. This is a distortion of truth engineered by forces opposing God's purpose. History proves without a doubt the Bible many read today is an accurate copy of the scriptures archaic people read. The "Dead Sea Scrolls" sheds light on this topic.

The Dead Sea Scrolls are ancient biblical writings dating from 3rd century B.C. up to 68 A.D. These scrolls were found in caves in Old Testament was found in these ancient scrolls [with the exclusion of the book of Esther]. Experts found these writings and were shocked that these ancient scrolls were accurate in detail with the Bible we read today.

The only difference among the two Bible's is the translations. There are different translations of the Bible. The Bible is written in many different forms. The wording may vary from one Bible to another, but the overall meaning is the same. This is done so the reader can understand the verses better. No one has changed the information. The only change is slight variation of the wording.

Many people are familiar with the King James Version of the Bible, but this writing is difficult to read and understand. Most of the words used are words people do not use in an everyday conversation. These are words such as "thou sayest" or "did thou believest". Modern translations help one understand the Bible more clearly. The following is a comparison of a verse from two popular used Bibles.

King James Version [KJV]	New American Standard [NASB]
(Gen.3:9) And the Lord God	(Gen.3:9) Then the Lord God called

Which is easier to read? Clearly the NASB because the wording is similar to English language people use today. Has the content changed? Is the overall meaning the same? The only difference is the language; therefore the Bible has not been altered

by man.

Men "*rewrote*" the Bible translating it into different languages, but it was not written by men of today. The Bible is rewritten in simpler language to give better understanding to all people of different races and cultures.

Our last question was "are you saved?" After reading this you should have already accepted Jesus Christ as your personal Savior (or ready to do so now). If you are still doubtful, hopefully the information encourages you to investigate more about Jesus Christ. Remember it is important that you accept Jesus Christ sooner than later!

Satan or Devil (God's enemy) wants to deceive as many people as possible to sin against God's word and command. His biggest deception is tricking people into putting off accepting Jesus Christ as their Savior the moment a person hears and believes the works of Jesus Christ. Satan works hard to destroy mankind and God's order on earth. The Bible teaches the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life (Rom.6:23).

Remember every one is born into sin because of Adam's sin. Accepting Jesus Christ as your payment for sin is important because Jesus was sent by God to redeem mankind. His death on

on the cross puts you in a proper relationship with God. Your Father is calling you today. What have you got to lose? If you believe the things you've read and confess Jesus Christ the Son of God as your Lord and payment for sin, you can, you are saved (Rom.10:9,10)! Your Father is calling you now (Mat.11:28-30, Rev.3:20), heed the call!

Say the following prayer if you are ready to confess Jesus Christ as your Lord and personal Savior:

Heavenly Father I come before you to ask for recognize that I am a sinner and believe that cleanse me from all my sins. Lord I believe invite you into my heart. I accept you as my forgiveness of my sins in Jesus name. I Jesus Christ is your son and died for me to you rose from the dead with all power and I Lord and personal Savior and submit to your

will this day. I thank you for giving me this opportunity to confess your name in Jesus name I pray. Amen.
