From The Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

I want to wish all of you a Happy and Blessed Easter. May the Risen Christ bless you and your families as you gather for your Easter celebrations. Also, I want to thank all of our parishioners for their ongoing support for the parish.

One week from today is Divine Mercy Sunday. While Easter Sunday is the holiest of all solemnities in the Church calendar year, the second Sunday after Easter is now considered the second holiest. Why? Because, it is on this Sunday that Jesus has promised to pour forth upon the earth torrents of His merciful love. We are indebted to His messenger St. Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun who, in the 1930s, received numerous messages from Jesus. In St. Faustina's diary, Jesus mentions His desire for this Feast of Mercy 14 different times.

On one occasion Our Lord said the following: My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the Fount of My Mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come forth from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy.

Corpus Christi Parish will celebrate the Feast of Divine Mercy with great solemnity. In addition to attending the weekend masses (as we are obliged to do), everyone is welcome to attend a special Divine Mercy Eucharistic Holy Hour in the parish church on Sunday, April 28th @ 3 p.m. Confessions will be heard before the service. Members of the Divine Mercy Prayer Group will distribute prayer brochures and fly-

ers for parishioners.

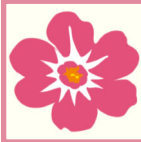

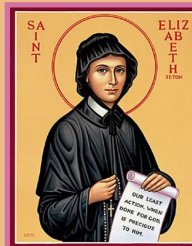
