## Sagebrush Inn & Suites, Taos, New Mexico



Built by Helen and Frank Kentnor in 1929, the Inn was built in a traditional Southwestern manner, timber from the surrounding forests was used for the vigas and adobe bricks made from mud and straw were laid into 24-inch walls and history, and car history. The Inn was originally built to handle guests traveling via car or carriage from New York on the way to winter in Arizona. Many famous people have come to visit over the years; Hollywood figures, politicians and artists such as Georgia O'Keefe.

The Sagebrush Inn has been owned and run by the Blair family for almost thirty years. Envisioning a new phase for this historical gathering place, Kenneth and his wife, Louise, have



added on, remodeled and refurbished the property.

Currently, Louise is the General Manager and Kenneth is the Executive Chef, both contributing to a professional yet personal setting.
