

- HOPE (Hearing Other People's Experiences): A retired audiologist moderates perspectives on hearing loss and answers your questions.



Our meetings are hearing accessible (*induction loop, captioning, interpreter provided by NTID for evening programs*).

- HLAA's monthly newsletter includes upcoming events, information and news about our daytime and evening educational programs.
- Our Demo Center for Assistive Listening Devices is open once a month (September to June) to show you the latest technology to improve your quality of life.
- Cochlear implant group meets on an ongoing basis for information and support.
- Hearing Accessibility and Looping: We promote the installation of communication systems (hearing loops, FM, infrared and open captioning) that make public places friendlier to those of us with hearing loss.
- **Professional Advisory Committee** (PAC): Our chapter relies on community professionals to provide counsel and guidance when needed.
- Featured Speaker Program: Hear from experts in the field about recent technological advances and the psychological implications of hearing loss for people and their families.
