My dear brothers and sisters, In the Bible, three groups of people are always mentioned together; the strangers, the widows and the orphans. They are the most vulnerable; they have no one to defend or to protect them. We can better understand the commitments that the Lord gives us towards these groups of people if we contemplate on the word empathy. The word empathy implies a deep feeling with a suffering person. It implies a kind of an emotional sharing or getting into the situation of a person who suffers. The Lord in the first reading of today calls on the Jews to have such a feeling for the strangers, considering that they too were once strangers in the land of Egypt. In ancient days, just as it is today, people travelled a lot to safer and more productive countries. They travelled mostly because they were either fleeing from wars, oppressions, hunger and other forms of hardship. I am sure the situation is not much different today. While reminding the Jews that they too had been strangers before, the Lord instructs them: 'You must not molest the stranger or oppress him'. This reading is very relevant to us today because certainly, there is no country in the world with as many strangers and the USA. Today, the Lord is evoking our sense of empathy. He reminds us that love is the greatest commandment. May God fill our hearts with abundant love for others so that the world would be a better place to live.

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas: En la Biblia, tres grupos de personas siempre se mencionan juntos; los extraños, las viudas y los huérfanos. Ellos son los más vulnerables; no tienen a nadie para defenderlos ni para protegerlos. Podemos comprender mejor los compromisos que el Señor nos da a estos grupos de personas si contemplamos la palabra empatía. La palabra empatía implica un sentimiento profundo con una persona que sufre. Implica una especie de compartir emocional o entrar en la situación de una persona que sufre. El Señor en la primera lectura de hoy llama a los judíos a tener tal sentimiento por los extraños, considerando que ellos también fueron extraños en la tierra de Egipto. En la antigüedad, tal como es hoy, las personas viajaban mucho a países más seguros y productivos. Viajaron principalmente porque huían de las guerras, las opresiones, el hambre y otras formas de dificultades. Estoy seguro de que la situación no es muy diferente hoy. Mientras les recordaba a los judíos que ellos también habían sido forasteros anteriormente, el Señor les instruye: 'No debes molestar al extraño ni oprimirlo'. Esta lectura es muy relevante para nosotros hoy porque ciertamente, no hay ningún país en el mundo con tantos extraños y EE. UU. Hoy, el Señor está evocando nuestro sentido de empatía. El nos recuerda que el amor es el mayor mandamiento. Que Dios llene nuestros corazones con abundante amor por los demás para que el mundo sea un mejor lugar para vivir.

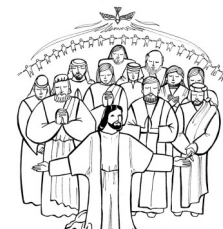
