Lectura, as de Hoy

Isaías 63:17,19b;64:2-7 Salmo
80:2acy 3b,15-16,18-19; 1 Corintios
1:3-9; Marcos 13:33-37

Why did God give us free will? A lot of people wonder about this and have asked me this question. This is not a new question. In the reading from Isaiah we here the question "Why do you let us wander, O LORD, from your ways, and harden our hearts so that we fear you not?" This type of question reveals our deep yearning for God and our desire to be in his favor. God created us and we love Him but we fall away from Him through our sinfulness. Salvation would be so much simpler if we could just skip the life part. We are born into a world that is complicated and messy. There are so many choices we have to make, so many influences pushing us one way and another, so many temptations. Deep down however we have a deep yearning to love God. As St. Augustine says, "Our hearts are restless until they can find rest in you." What we hear in the first reading is an acknowledgement of our sinfulness (all of us have become like unclean people, all our good deeds are like polluted rags; we have all withered like leaves) and our complete dependence on God (Yet, O LORD, you are our father; we are the clay and you the potter: we are all the work of your hands). As we begin this Advent season, let us rejoice in the fact that we love God and desire to be near Him while at the same time asking Him to help us turn from our sinfulness.

¿Por qué Dios nos dio libre albedrío? Muchas personas se preguntan sobre esto y me han hecho esta pregunta. Esta no es una pregunta nueva. En la lectura de Isaías, nos encontramos aquí con la pregunta: "¿Por qué nos apartas, oh Jehová, de tus caminos, y endureces nuestros corazones para que no te tememos?" Este tipo de pregunta revela nuestro profundo anhelo por Dios y nuestro deseo de estar a su favor. Dios nos creó y lo amamos, pero nos apartamos de Él a través de nuestra pecaminosidad. La salvación sería mucho más simple si pudiéramos omitir la parte de la vida. Nacemos en un mundo que es complicado y desordenado. Hay tantas opciones que tenemos que tomar, tantas influencias que nos empujan de una manera u otra, tantas tentaciones. En el fondo, sin embargo, tenemos un profundo anhelo de amar a Dios. Como dice San Agustín, "nuestros corazones están inquietos hasta que puedan encontrar descanso en ti". Lo que escuchamos en la primera lectura es un reconocimiento de nuestra pecaminosidad (todos nosotros hemos llegado a ser como personas inmundas, todas nuestras buenas obras están como contaminadas). tramos, todos nos hemos marchitado como hojas) y nuestra completa dependencia de Dios (Sin embargo, oh SENOR, tú eres nuestro padre, nosotros somos el barro y tú el alfarero; todos somos obra de tus manos). Al comenzar esta temporada de Adviento, regocijémonos en el hecho de que amamos a Dios y deseamos estar cerca de Él, al mismo tiempo que le pedimos que nos ayude a abandonar nuestra pecaminosidad.
