The healing of the leper is one of the first miracles that Jesus performs in the Gospel of Mark. The priority of this act reveals that lepers hold a special place in Jesus' heart. They are the kind of people that Jesus reaches out to with special compassion. The leper is one of the first people upon whom Jesus lavishes his love.

The irony is that the law of the time forbade lepers to get close to healthy people. Lepers were mandated to keep their distance and to live in isolation. That is why the opening words of the Gospel are so shocking: "A leper approached." By making that illegal move, the leper risks receiving a punishment harsher than the daily curse of his disease.

We are called today to take every step, every disposition, even those we consider risky to approach Jesus. In the same way we must show compassion to all as Christ did.

La curación del leproso es uno de los primeros milagros que Jesús realiza en el Evangelio de Marcos. La prioridad de este acto revela que los leprosos ocupan un lugar especial en el corazón de Jesús. Son el tipo de personas con las que Jesús se acerca con especial compasión. El leproso es una de las primeras personas sobre quienes Jesús prodiga su amor.

La ironía es la ley del tiempo prohibía a los leprosos acercarse a personas sanas. Los leprosos tenían el mandato de mantener su distancia y vivir en aislamiento. Es por eso que las primeras palabras del Evangelio son tan impactantes: "Se acercó un leproso". Al hacer ese movimiento ilegal, el leproso corre el riesgo de recibir un castigo más severo que la maldición diaria de su enfermedad.

Hoy estamos llamados a dar cada paso, cada disposición, incluso aquellos que consideramos riesgosos para acercarnos a Jesús. De la misma manera, debemos mostrar compasión a todos como lo hizo Cristo.

Lenten Guidelines

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

Members of the Eastern Catholic Churches are to observe the particular law of their own *sui iuris* Church.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

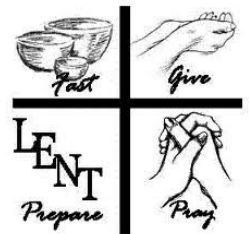
