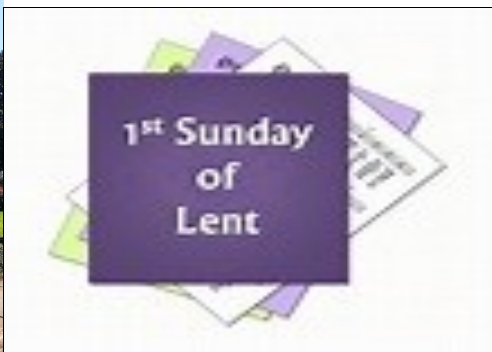

The characteristics of Lent make this season radically different from all the other liturgical season of the Church. The purple color that we use is a symbol of penitent. This is what is highlighted most in this season. The fact that we omit the singing of our Gloria and Alleluias which are joyful in character also signifies the penitential character of this season. The three pillars of Lent are Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving

Inspired by the Gospel text, I want us today to reflect on Jesus, being conducted to the desert, where he is tempted and tested. Temptation is something that all of us deal with almost every day in our journey of faith. We shall face more temptation during this season because we are actually obliged to do more in terms of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. It is interesting to note that Jesus was taken to the desert by the Spirit, where he is tempted by Satan. However, the Angels were equally there to minister to Him. While we have the enemies tempting us all the time, we also have the angels, watching over us. May God grant us the graces for a fruitful lent.

Inspirado por el texto del Evangelio, quiero que hoy reflexionemos sobre Jesús, que nos conduzca al desierto, donde es tentado y probado. La tentación es algo que todos nosotros tratamos casi todos los días en nuestro camino de fe. Tendremos más tentaciones durante esta temporada porque estamos obligados a hacer más en términos de oración, ayuno y limosna. Es interesante notar que Jesús fue llevado al desierto por el Espíritu, donde Satanás lo tentó. Sin embargo, los Ángeles estaban igualmente allí para ministrarle. Mientras que los enemigos nos tientan todo el tiempo, también tenemos a los ángeles que nos vigilan. Que Dios nos conceda las gracias por un préstamo fructífero.

on the following dates:

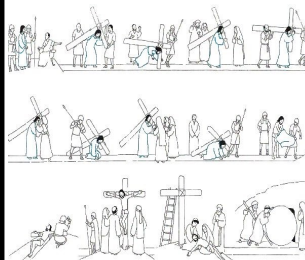

Lenten Guidelines

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

Members of the Eastern Catholic Churches are to observe the particular law of their own *sui iuris* Church.

If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily his Resurrection.

Baptism and Marriage

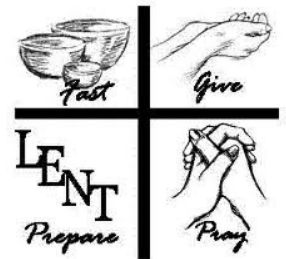
You are required to be a registered parishioner and a practicing Catholic to be baptized or married at the church. Please call the office to set-up an appointment with the Pastor.
