Paul shocks us with the enormous scope of the good news. While we were still dead, still in sin, God gave us new life in the friendship of Jesus and pardoned our sins. It is very easy to twist the good news into the not so good news. We are tempted to distort the gospel to make it say that only if you turn from your sin will God pardon you. But this is not really good news. How is this different from the way the world runs? No, while we were still in sin, God reached out to us in Jesus and died for us, unworthy as we were and are. God has already reconciled all sinners past, present, and future. The gospel proclaims that this reconciliation has happened. Now in the light of what God has done, what is your response? God has already buried your sins in the grave with Christ. Will you not come and be part of the victory feast thrown in your honor? Do you want to go back and continue in your old ways? Let us come back to God irrespective of our short comings and enjoy his reconciliation.

No, mientras aún estábamos en pecado, Dios se acercó a nosotros en Jesús y murió por nosotros, indignos como éramos y somos. Dios ya ha reconciliado a todos los pecadores pasados, presentes y futuros. El evangelio proclama que esta reconciliación ha sucedido.

Ahora, a la luz de lo que Dios ha hecho, ¿cuál es tu respuesta? Dios ya ha sepultado tus pecados en la tumba con Cristo. ¿No vendrás y serás parte de la fiesta de la victoria en tu honor?

¿Quieres volver y continuar en tus viejos caminos? Volvamos a Dios independientemente de nuestras pequeñas venidas, Y disfrutar de su reconciliación.
