#### **NEW THOUGHTS ON THE FRS RADIO**

Have you ever been horseback riding, cycling, or back packing and lost track of someone in your group? Have you ever been to Disneyland and can't find one of your family members? If you had had a FRS radio (Family Radio Service) the anxiety could be reduced. We often think of emergencies as the only need for an FRS radio when we want to check on our neighbors, but actually it works in many situations.

Our YOYO Committee has found it is possible to communicate to all corners of Juniper Hills, Lake LA, and Littlerock. We know in a big emergency phones will be overloaded, or wires may be down making it impossible to even call your local neighbors with landline or cell phone. Your FRS could save a life.

There are many brands of FRS radios and prices. Many of us have Motorola radios, they work well and are rechargeable, ranging in price from \$40 to \$60 dollars for a pair with charging base. They can be purchased at Best Buy, Amazon, Walmart and many more stores. They can even be waterproof for those of you that do water sports.

Our YOYO/CERT group would love to have you join our Monday night check in at 7: 00PM on channel 14. We feel the practice is very important to know we can reach each other and also CERT members outside our community.

We pass this information on to you so that you can PREPARE YOURSELF for any event when communication is prime.
