Director/Writer's Note:

In 1993, I directed a production of Jean Anouilh's Antigone at Orange Coast College. That production has special siginificance; for one thing, many of the cast members went on to become founding members of the Hunger Artists. It also contributed to my abiding fascination with the stories in the Theban Cycle: Of Laius, who ran headlong into his predestined Fate by trying to escape it; of Oedipus, whose arrogantly sought the truth even when everyone around him begged

him to leave it alone; and of Antigone, who accepted death as the price of duty. These are the foundation myths, the proto-stories if you will, and the power emodied in them is as potent today as it was two thousand years ago. I hope I've given Ismene her due.
