Ways to earn points ...

<u>How?</u>	<u>How many points?</u>	<u>Example</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dress up for each Spirit Week dress-up day 	Participating percentage of the class	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If 42% of the freshmen dress up on Tuesday, the freshman class will earn 42 points for the day.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Find the Scavenger Hunt items for the day (Monday—football jerseys; Tuesday—footballs; Wednesday—megaphones; Thursday—football helmets; Friday—crowns) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Each regular item will be worth 5 points each. One specially marked item will be worth 10 points. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If members of the sophomore class find six of the items, the sophomore class will earn 30 points for the day. If members of the senior class find three items and the specially marked item, the senior class will earn 25 points for the day.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Win the Minute to Win It challenges each day during lunch 	Representatives from each class will participate in three (3) games during each lunch; the winning class for each game earns 10 points	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If the freshman representatives win two games during first lunch, the freshman class will earn 20 points. If the junior representatives win one game during second lunch, the junior class will earn 10 points.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Win Friday's volleyball bash (or be runner-up should the faculty team win) 	50 points for the winning class	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If the juniors win the volleyball bash or make it to the final game against the faculty, the junior class will earn 50 points for the day.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Win the Spirit Stick at Friday's pep rally 	50 points for the winning class	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If the seniors win the Spirit Stick, the senior class will earn 50 points for the day.

Ways to lose points ...

<u>How?</u>	<u>How many points?</u>	<u>Example</u>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Attendance 	Percentage of the class absent will be deducted from total	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If 12% of the seniors are absent on Tuesday, the senior class will lose 12 points for the day.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tardies 	Percentage of the class tardy will be deducted from total	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If 14% of the juniors are tardy, the junior class will lose 14 points for the day.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Discipline 	Percentage of the class receiving discipline referrals will be deducted from total	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If 6% of the sophomores receive discipline referrals, the sophomore class will lose 6 points for the day.
