### Holy Habits

So I have some habits, or *acquired behavior patterns regularly followed until they have become almost involuntary*. Some of these habits are just things that I've done since I was a kid. One of these is that when I'm shooting hoops in the driveway, I have to make the last shot before I quit. I can't stop shooting on a miss. (I'm not sure why this habit started, but it is ingrained.) Some habits are learned for a particular reason. For instance, many learn habits that might also be called manners. Table manners taught me to place a napkin on my lap during supper. There is a reason behind this practice. When something is spilled, the napkin will save my pants.

Many of the things we do in church could become habits that extend beyond the church. We pray before we serve communion, and many of us stop and pray before we eat our meals. We read the Bible, and then stop and try and make sense of what it means, with the help of a preacher or teacher. We sing songs of praise to God, and we sing words that take the matters of faith or stories of the Bible and put them to melody to help us interact with them a different way. We share with one another the things that we are happy about, and the things that are troubling us. You know, I think these are behavior patterns that we ought to also live out outside of the church as well. And some of you do. If you eat your meal without pausing to say a prayer, and something seems off, that could be an indication that you've developed a healthy, holy, habit. Hooray! Hallelujah! (All habits aren't good, but these are!)

Part of developing holy habits (what the church often calls *disciplines*, which can sound kind of harsh), is developing them through frequency. In other words, you can't develop the habit of reading the Bible, unless you *regularly* read the Bible. (Makes sense, right!) You can't develop the habit of praying for your family daily, if you only pray during church. You can't develop the habit of attending worship weekly, if you only go once a month. You see developing holy habits means building up to greater frequency in whatever the desired behavior is. A lot of times people say, if you can do something (or not do something) for a month than you have a habit, or have broken a habit. The Church likes 40 days, so that's what they went with, and during the 40 days prior to Easter, the Church has encouraged people to work on holy habits, to work towards frequency with their desired spiritual behaviors. Why? So that at Easter we can say we're closer to God than we were, because we have taken the time to intentionally do something (or not do something). One of the ways the Church kicks off this exercise is through a service on Ash Wednesday, which this year is also Valentine's Day (Feb. 14 – don't you *love* that). We have our foreheads marked with ashes to remind us of the fragile nature of our earthly lives. We are reminded that we aren't guaranteed a tomorrow, but that we can devote our selves to holiness with Jesus today, and confessing our sins, we receive again the Good News of God's forgiveness in Jesus Christ, our Savior. It is one of the more meaningful services of the Church year, and we observe it at a 7am service (before work or school) and at a 7pm service. Come out and think about what holy habits you might want to work on in your life with God!

I hope to see you Sunday!

If one of you says to him, 'Go, I wish you well; keep warm and well fed,' but does nothing about his physical needs, what good is it?" (James 2:15-16 NIV).*

Faith is more than something you feel. Many people confuse emotions and feelings with faith. They come to church and they're moved emotionally, they're inspired, and they're stimulated. But that doesn't mean they're walking in faith.

The Bible says faith is something we do, not just something we feel. In other words, faith is not mere sentimentality.

Let's say I go out on the street and see someone who is homeless and destitute. I see that this person is hungry, cold, and in need of clothing and shelter. Would I be showing great faith if I walked up and said, "Cheer up! Don't worry; be happy! Feel good! Put on a happy face"?

It doesn't take much faith to do that. Faith produces compassion. Faith says, "I'll do anything I can to stop your hurt." Throughout the New Testament, the witnesses say Jesus was moved with compassion for people. Jesus *showed* us that faith is practical.

When we see a need, we do something about it. We don't just toss out a quick "Well, I'll pray for you." The Bible says we show our faith by what we do.
