For others fall's coming is exciting because of the things that accompany those seasonal changes: apple harvesting, apple cider donuts, and all things pumpkin spice. Still others get really into Halloween and dress up in crazy and unexpected ways (like your parsonage family!). This October in worship, we're gonna explore sin and evil and the role it plays in our lives. This isn't going to be in a scary kind of way, but in a way that invites us to pull back the curtain on those things that we like to hide away. This Sunday, October 7<sup>th</sup>, we will observe World Communion Sunday, and all the connections we have globally with fellow Christians, and the way the Gospel unites us.

Our church's charge conference will be Sunday November 4, 2018, following our late worship service. One of the things that charge conference offers is a chance to meet the District Superintendent and to talk about where we've been and where we're going as a local church. To help with these conversations we're going to have a visioning conversation on Sunday Oct. 14<sup>th</sup>, at 3pm. All church members and participants are welcome to come and be apart of this important conversation.

I'm looking forward to all the things the busy fall has in store for our church family!



#### **Reflections from Russia!**

As you may know, between August 6<sup>th</sup> and August 15<sup>th</sup>, I participated in a mission trip to visit Pastor Irina and our friends in Stavropol, Russia. I went with three members of the Baltimore-Washington Conference, Charles Harrell, Tom, Ann Dudley, and met up with Mel Munchinski, the General Board of General Missions Eurasia In Mission Together Coordinator in Moscow. The five of us then traveled first to Voronezh to participate in work at a Methodist Camp and Retreat center that provides camping experiences for Russians with disabilities. Our work there was rewarding as we met many Russian Methodists from throughout the country, some coming farther than we traveled—Russia is a HUGE country!

From there we traveled to Stavropol, to visit with Irina and her congregation and to visit the Roma village where Irina is doing mission work with the Roma people. I think Mel put it best that this was a "ministry of presence." We didn't "do" anything special, but our mere presence meant so much to them. They were amazed that we would take the time and resources to simply come and visit. We had some interesting flight connection issues on the way to Stavropol, but by God's grace we were able to arrive so we could fellowship with them on Sunday morning for worship. The service was 2 ½ hours long and simply wonderful. There were about 25 people in attendance, including the 5 of us. After worship, like the good Methodists we are, we ate!

During the afternoon and the next day, we visited with our Russian friends, saw the sights of Stavropol, traveled to the Roma village and met families there and shared meals and tea with them, and participated in a Skype bible study that is conducted by a Methodist layperson from Tulsa, Oklahoma every Monday evening—7 pm in Stavropol, 10am in Tulsa.

I left Stavropol with a great fondness for our fellow Methodists there and saw how faithfully they are applying the gifts we send from our Mission budget to assist their work in Stavropol. I hope to return soon to visit them again. Here are a couple of the photos I took of our time together. Thank you for your prayers and support for me. And thank you for your tithes and offerings that go toward providing support for Irina and the Methodist Church in Stavropol.
