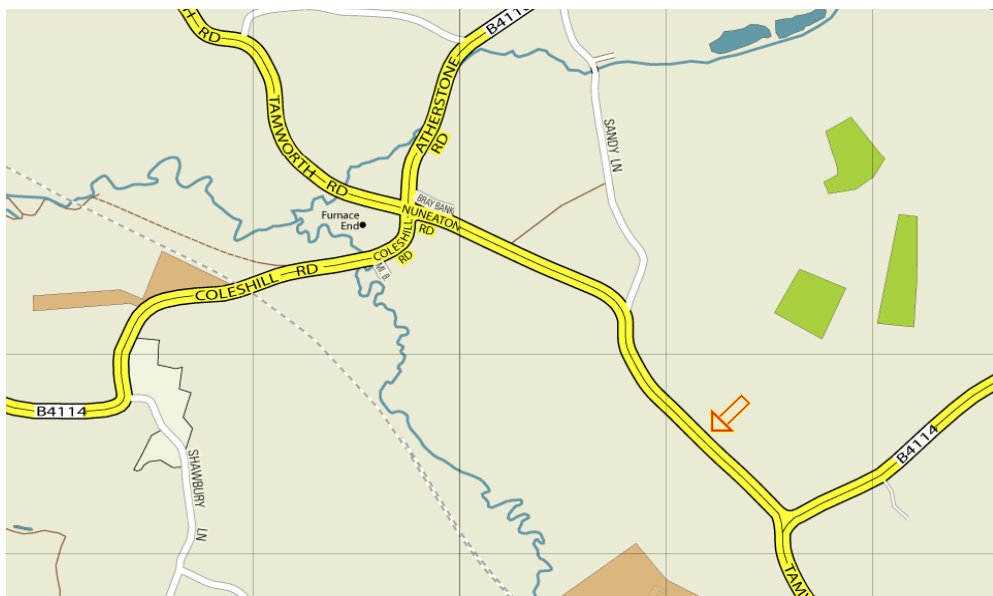

# Ring One

## Show Jumping Classes:

**Barrel Jumping:** Starting at 9.00am

Entrance Fee: £3.00

Rosettes to 4<sup>th</sup> place

**Class 1:** Lead Rein

**Class 2:** Open

A chance for all to have a little jumping fun. Starting at 5 barrels laid flat, keep your mount jumping straight & clean. One barrel being removed after each round until we are left with just one. Cleanest, straightest jump wins!

**Mini Jumping (Shortened Course):** Starting at 9.30am

Entrance Fee £3.00

Rosettes to 4th place

**\*Class 1 40cm (1'3") Lead Rein**

**\*Class 2 50cm (1'6") Open Mini Jumping**

**Clear Round:** Starting at approx 10.30am (entries close 11am)

Entrance fee : £3.00 or two for £5.00

Rosettes to all clears

**50cm (1ft 6") Clear Round**

**Open Jumping (Two Phase):** Starting at approx 11.30am

Entrance fee : £5.00

Rosettes to 4th place

**\*Class 3 55cm (1'9")**

**\*Class 4A 60cm (2ft) NO FILLERS** (non points class)

**\*Class 4 60cm (2ft)** - Sponsored by Mick's Food Bar

**\*Class 5A 70cm (2ft 3") NO FILLERS** (non points class)

**\*Class 5 70cm (2ft 3")** - Sponsored by GSP Equestrian

*\*These classes are for genuine Novice horses and/or riders. We ask all riders to enter these classes accordingly*

Not before 1.00pm

**Class 6 75cm (2ft 6")**

**Class 7 85cm (2ft 9")**

**Class 8 90cm (3ft)**

**Two Phase :** Competitors will jump the untimed course and only clear rounds will immediately progress to be timed over the second section without interruption. Those incurring faults will be halted by the bell after completing the first phase. Horses and ponies will jump the same course but will be judged and rosettes given separately.

**When entering you MUST declare if you are jumping a horse or a pony. Ponies 14.2 (148cm) and under. Horses over 14.2 (148cm)**

**Penalties** incurred for knock down (4), crossing path/turning circle (4), refusal (first refusal at a fence 4, second at same fence 8), third refusal at any fence (elimination), fall of horse or rider (elimination).

**Entries for all classes (except clear round) close 5 minutes after the start of that class, after which time entry will be subject to a £1 late entry fee.**

### Show Jumping specific Rules and Regulations

1. Show/Hacking jackets must be worn in all jumping events unless specified by the judge. Where jackets are not worn, shoulders must be covered.
2. Studs, spurs and whips will be allowed in the jumping ring but excessive use may lead to disqualification. Riders under 14 may not wear spurs.
3. Practice jumps, these must be jumped with the red flag on the RIGHT hand side.
4. The height of the practice jump must not exceed the height of the fences in the current show jumping class.
5. All entries for the jumping classes are to be made BEFORE the start of the class, exception is the clear round where entries will close at 11.00am, or where the appropriate late entry fees have been paid. Late entries are at the discretion of the Secretary.
6. Any competitor who takes a fall will be eliminated and must leave the ring dismounted.
7. If you are eliminated for any other reason you may jump a SINGLE fence before leaving the ring.
8. The course builders/judge will have the final say in height due to weather conditions on the day. Heights stated are maximum for the first round and may be higher for the jump off section.
9. Any horse rider combination winning or being placed 2nd more than twice (4 competitors or more) will not be eligible to take part competitively in the following classes:
  - 1'9" and above winners/2nds not eligible for mini jumping
  - 2'3" and above not eligible for 1'9" class
  - 2'6" and above not eligible for 2'0" class
  - 2'9" and above not eligible for 2'3" class
  - 3'0" and above not eligible for 2'6" class
10. Any BSJA registered horse/pony may not jump competitively in classes 1-5
11. Competitors are reminded, that entering the mini jumping excludes entry into any Open Jumping class on the same horse/pony on the same show day
12. No horse or pony may compete in more than three open jumping classes on one day.

## Ring Two

### Showing Commences at 10am

Entrance Fee : £5.00 per class

Rosettes to 4th place

### **Class 1: Best Turned Out (In Hand or Ridden)**

Sponsored by Alan Green

Horse/Pony must be correctly and immaculately presented to the judge.

Scoring: Overall view 40% Horse/Pony 30% Rider/Handler 30%

### **Class 2: In Hand Open**

Annual Points Class for the Margret Brown Trophy.

There will be a separate award for Best Veteran sponsored by The Samuel Barlow Freehouse

Scoring: Manners 20% Conformation 60% Overall Presentation 20%

### **Class 3: In Hand Best Handler or In Hand Best Condition**

(Non-Points Class)

Shows on 22 April, 24 June, 29 July and 9 September ~ Best Handler.

Shows on 20 May, 8 July, 19 August, 23 September ~ Best Condition

### **Class 4: In Hand Youngstock or In Hand Coloured**

(Non-Points Class)

Shows on 22 April, 24 June, 29 July and 9 September ~ Youngstock.

Shows on 20 May, 8 July, 19 August, 23 September ~ Coloured

### **\*\*\*IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP\*\*\***

**Open to all in hand winners & runners up from classes 1-4**

### **Class 5: Novice Ridden (not before 12 noon)**

Open to any combination who have not been placed in any showing class at the start of the season. Snaffle bridle, no spurs. No canter work.

Scoring: Position of Rider 20% Correctness and effectiveness of aids 20% Individual show 30% Overall presentation 30%

### **Class 6: Best Rider**

Scoring: Position of Rider 20% Correctness and effectiveness of aids 20% Individual show 30% Overall presentation 30%

### **Class 7: Mountain and Moorland (Ridden)**

Sponsored class

Open to Native breeds (Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh ~ no part-breds)

Scoring: Correctness of breed type and conformation 60% Manners 20% Overall presentation 20%

### **Class 8: Riding Club Horse/Pony**

Will be expected to jump a small fence.

Scoring: Suitability 30% Performance & manners 25% Overall presentation 25% Jumping (optional) 20%

### **Class 9: Ridden Cob (any type)**

Scoring: Conformation 40% Manners 20% Individual Show 20% Overall presentation 20%

*Classes 2-4 will be split into Juniors & Seniors, classes 1 and 5-9 will be split into Lead Rein, Juniors & Seniors with rosettes awarded separately **subject to sufficient entries**. If amalgamated annual points will be awarded separately.*

Dressage Entries close on the **Wednesday** before the show and **all dressage tests must be booked and paid for in advance.**

Dressage times are available by telephoning **07949 505880** on the

Thursday before the show, between 6pm and 9pm only.

No refunds after the closing date. Correct dress code must be adhered to, gloves are compulsory.

Times are allocated on a random basis. We are sorry that we might not be able to accommodate special requests for times.

**Your Dressage time takes precedence over all other classes**

**Classes 1 and 2 are split Junior, Senior Restricted and Open.**  
(Split classes subject to sufficient entries. If classes amalgamated annual points will be awarded separately)

**Restricted** is a combination of horse & rider not to have been placed 1st three times or more in a class of 3 or more competitors.

**Open** is any horse/rider combination that holds any British Dressage or British Eventing points, are currently Affiliated or that have been placed 1st three or more times at that level (i.e WT, Prelim, Novice). Points limits apply as per BD "bronze" rules, ie if a horse is ineligible at a BD competition then same rule applies at Hartshill Riding Club.

**If in doubt—please ask.**

Changes to sections cannot be made after the event.

Please ensure that you are at the collecting ring 10 mins before your allocated time and declare your intention to ride the test to the dressage steward. Failure to present in good time may result in the withdrawal of a competitor without the refund of fees. The show **MUST** run to time to ensure that we are fair to everyone.

The Judge's decision is final

### Health and Safety Policy for Hartshill Riding Club

**\*The Organisers have the overall responsibility for Health and Safety at our events . With this in mind , each competition is organised in accordance with Health and Safety Legislation .**

**\*Everything reasonably practicable is done to ensure the health, safety and welfare of those attending the shows .**

**\*For these measures to be effective, it is the individual responsibility of each person attending competitions to conduct themselves in such a way that they do not put themselves or anyone else at risk .**

**\*Horses can be dangerous. Members of the public are requested to keep clear of horse areas/lanes and avoid behaviour which might alarm horses.**

**\*Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.**

**\*Emergency vehicles must have access to all parts of the show site at all times . Vehicles must not be parked so as to obstruct access and are parked at the owners risk .**

**\*In case of an Emergency, members of the public should contact the nearest Official or dial 999 on the nearest Telephone .**

## Hartshill Riding Club Rules 2017

### General

1. Anyone riding on the showground must be a member.
2. Riders are to receive their rosettes mounted in the relevant ring at the end of the class (except Dressage). Failure may result in no annual points being allocated to them and disqualification.
3. Canter/Galloping is prohibited outside of any defined competition/warm-up ring.
4. All riders riding on the showground do so at their own risk.
5. All vehicles are parked at owners' risk.
6. Spectators, Competitors and Owners entering horses/ponies do so entirely at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind shall be attached to the organisers of Hartshill Riding Club.
7. **Hats conforming to the appropriate British safety standards** and correct footwear must be worn at all times when mounted by ALL riders and must be securely fastened.

## Hartshill Riding Club Rules 2017 continued

8. All riders should be the appropriate size and weight for their mount.
9. No practising is allowed in ANY of the rings before the class starts.
10. Lungeing is not permitted other than in designated areas.
11. All competitors are expected to have the horse they are riding, insured for themselves and 3<sup>rd</sup> party.
12. Members must have entered a class at least 3 times to be eligible for annual points and the end of year trophy for that class.
13. For those classes that carry annual points, these are awarded as follows  
4 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place  
3 points for 2<sup>nd</sup> place  
2 points for 3<sup>rd</sup> place  
1 point for 4<sup>th</sup> place
14. Any breach of the rules may result in the loss of points for the day.
15. Horses and ponies must not be left unattended when tied to horse boxes or trailers.
16. The organisers reserve the right to cancel/amend a class in any way.
17. Please respect club property at all times and do not leave litter on the grounds, including any horse droppings
18. Keep gate closed at all times
19. Objections to be submitted to a committee member in writing, within 30 minutes of the event, with a deposit of £10. If the objection is not sustained, such deposit will be forfeited.
20. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or alter the schedule without prior notice and refuse any entry.
21. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to the showground to any persons at any time.
22. The judge's decision is final.

### Lead Rein

1. All lead rein ponies must be 13.2hh or under
  2. Lead rein must not be attached to the bit
  3. Lead rein children are not allowed to compete on L/R in one class and off L/R in another
- Lead rein children may ride unaccompanied on the showground AT THE PARENTS' OWN DISCRETION
