When you allow me to be your minister for the moment, you may choose from the four following messages that greatly inspire me, or provide a theme from which you would like me to preach or teach. I'd be glad to oblige you.

- “Living in the Overflow”

It's time to stop playing small and step into God's overflow, the overflow of health, the overflow of prosperity, the overflow of joy, the overflow of peace, the overflow of *life* itself! Too often, we get caught up in living the “just enough,” but that's not how God designed us. We're designed to live in the “green pastures” mentioned in Psalm 23—the overflow.

- “For Such A Time As This (Your Gift Is Needed)”

That special something you have is needed right now, to be used the way only you can use it. Only you have the combination of gifts, experiences and knowledge you have, and only you can share them the way you will—for such a time as this. We'll examine the case of Hadassah, aka Esther, and how her and Mordecai's gifts saved them. If we all operated within our gifts, the world and the people in it would be very different. We can yet make that difference.

- “Put On the Whole Armor of God”

We leave ourselves open to attack if we don't wear our armor. Ephesians 6:13-17 gives us clear instruction about how to protect our whole selves from the wiles of the devil. We can stand to be reminded of how an armor works and how powerful it really is. We can stand to be reminded of what the armor looks like and how to use it.

- “The Five Womandments”

At many Women's Day celebrations, we hear about the Psalm 31 Woman. In this message, i elucidate some characteristics women can emulate in, not only that magnificent Psalm 31 Woman, but in Hanna, Phoebe, Abigail and the Widow with the mite. Sometimes i switch one of them out with Deborah because they all have attributes to help us be the best women we can be.

- “Love vs. Fear”

We think of Love as the foundation of life, as put forth by 1 Corinthians 13. And we naturally think of the opposite of love being hate. But hate is a symptom. The true opposite of love is fear, out of which come many other harmful symptoms beside hate. We'll discuss some of these symptoms, such as jealousy, unreasonable anger, prejudice—and we can discuss others—all stemming from fear, the opposite of love.

I studied Dr. Bill Winston's *The Law of Confession* and it was so powerful, i wanted to teach it. So, i wrote an unauthorized workbook for it and taught it.
