How did Valentine's Day start?:

The Legend of St. Valentine. The history of Valentine's Dayand the story of its patron saint—is shrouded in mystery. We do know that February has long been celebrated as a month of romance, and that St. Valentine's Day, as we know it today, contains vestiges of both Christian and ancient Roman tradition.

The Ancient Roman Influence:

This celebration would have boys draw a name of a girl from a box that contained the names of all the eligible girls in that area.

Program Summary:

HAPA and FD Options are working with a National Nonprofit Organization, which is committed to making homeownership a reality. The Lease With The Right To Purchase Program is different than any similar program. With this program, you have a contractual Right to purchase the house. This is to help people who can afford the monthly payment on a home, but can't qualify for a mortgage loan for whatever reason. You also get the right to choose the home in the neighborhood they want to live in.

Here's how it works. Once you choose the home that fits your families needs, a National Nonprofit Organization will purchase it. After they repair anything that needs it in the home, they will lease it to you, which costs about the same or less than the cost of monthly rents in your area. You will have five (5) years in California to qualify for a mortgage loan with the lender of your choice, and purchase the home.

To start the program, all you need to pay is two (2) monthly lease payments up front, and that serves as your down payment.

What about if there is a need for repairs while we're leasing the home?

Don't worry, the Nonprofit Organization provides a fund in case you need to replace the dishwasher, or fix a leak in the pipes, whatever needs to be repaired.

What if over the five (5) years period we decide the home we selected doesn't fit our needs?

That is another great thing about this program. If you decide that the house no longer fits your family's needs, you can opt out of the program and we will help you select another home to put into the program. That will start the 5 years over again and it works the same as the first house did.


