As part of the training each student learned how to administer Naloxone, a drug that can temporarily reverse the effects of opioids and potentially save someone from an overdose.

EACH STUDENTS WAS GIVEN A NALOXONE KIT TO TAKE HOME. If your child is under 18 years old, a parent/guardian will need to contact the school and make arrangements to have the Kit picked up.




