
<u>Wednesday Morning Group</u>



Iracy Arostegui . . .

What brought me to Unity? Like many people, I would have to say that all of my life I have felt drawn to the teachings of Unity, even if I didn't know the particulars of this church's existence. Since I was very young, and was being raised by a mother who was a strict Southern Baptist, I sensed that there was a greater truth, a greater love, and a greater connection with all in the universe that was not fully expressed or celebrated in the teachings of Christ I was being exposed to. Later in life, as an adult, finding myself challenged by raising an autistic son, I moved toward acupuncture, meditation, and yoga, and then, finally, Unity. Here I am at home! There is peace and acceptance here that I've long searched for and believed others must be searching for as well. I have found my community that has a guiding principle of love—not confined to or restricted by the teachings of any specific religion—that resonates with me. So, thank you to all of you for welcoming me into this church just over a year ago, and thank you for welcoming me into this new leadership position.

Rob Leaming . . .

Hi, My name is Rob Leaming, I came to Unity about 3 1/2 years ago seeking a local spiritual community which I have found here. My diverse background includes business management, community relations, problem solving and education which I feel will be of great resource as a board member here at Unity Spiritual Life Center of Yakima. I have been making Yakima County my home for the past 18 years, the longest I have ever lived in one place. I currently work privately building a model of transformation I call Hawkshaven. From this platform I teach ways that we can create our landscape into a sustainable symbiotic relationship (permaculture) where people and nature thrive. Natures influence has helped me dive deeply into my spiritual path implementing the practice of Yoga that I also teach at Hawkshaven. Additionally I have enjoyed teaching Yoga/Meditation this past year at the Yoga Collective of Yakima, a workshop here at Unity, and most recently in local schools. Thank you for giving me this opportunity to serve you.

Rick Welke . . .

I have been in pharmacy since I was 18 years old, first as a technician in the Army later on as a pharmacist after a stint at WSU. I came to Yakima in 1986, and attended the Nazarene Church with my wife Joy and our 3 children. After our children were grown we drifted away from that spiritual community, and after a few years two friends who attended Unity invited us to visit. Joy attended services for a couple of weeks before I did, and when I came for the first time I was very pleased, indeed surprised at the positive spiritual energy that we encountered. That was 11 years ago, and USLC has become a very important part of my life since then.

In the fall of 2008 I was asked by the nominating committee to "throw my hat into the ring" and become a board member. At our first meeting a vacancy as treasurer opened up, and I thought that might be an important way to serve USLC. I had no previous experience as a treasurer, but managing pharmacies helped me wrap my mind around the task. I would come to learn over the next 4 years that church finances are quite different than business or family budgeting, and this period of my life proved to be an enormous growth experience for me. Over this 4 year period a lot of important events and challenges came before the Board, and we met those circumstances with deliberation, teamwork, and faith. Although our Center faces daunting challenges now, that is nothing new over the history of Unity in Yakima since its inception. What lies before us is not much different than Unity has faced over its 80 year history, and with the teamwork of a dedicated Board of Trustees, and an involved and supportive congregation, I believe that with faith, creativity, perseverance and love - we can navigate any upcoming rapids until we enter the calm placid waters, and be better off for the journey.
