HOW TO REGISTER: Advanced entry to Knights64@yahoo.com with full name, grade, school and contact number. All players must know how to each piece moves and captures.

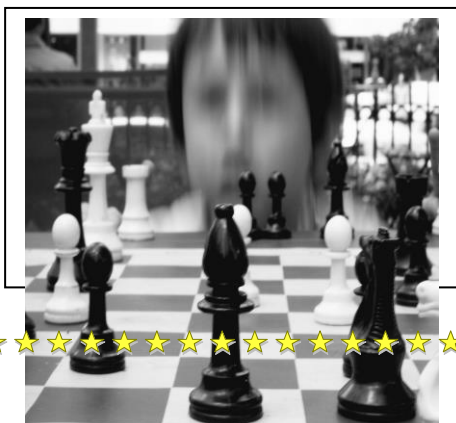
Registration Deadline by Saturday, December 29th.
