

## Flowers with a Twist



### CUTTING GUIDE:

This card is a standard A2 card (4 ¼ x 5 ½) made out of Basic Black cardstock. Cut the cardstock in half on the 11" side at 5 ½" and then score at 4 ¼" on the 8 ½" side. This will give you two card bases. Set one aside.

This card consists of 4 layers (not including the card base). Cut each layer as follows:

Layer 1 (Lemon Lime Twist cardstock) 4" x 5 ¼"

Layer 2 (Whisper White cardstock) 3" x 4" and a black accent layer 3 1/8" x 4 1/8"

Layer 3 (Lemon Lime Twist cardstock) 3" x 2" and a black accent layer 3 1/8" x 2 1/8"

Layer 4 (Whisper White cardstock) 2 ½" circle and a black accent layer at 2 ¾"

Inside card (Whisper White cardstock) 4" x 5 ¼"

Envelope (Whisper White cardstock) 8" x 8"



## RECIPE:

### Outside of card:

Using fast fuse or snail adhesive (or any adhesive that you have) adhere Layer 1 to the card base.

Using the Whisper White cardstock cut for Layer 2, stamp randomly one flower from the Flower Shop stamp set using Lemon Lime Twist ink creating your own background paper, then adhere to the basic black accent piece cut for Layer 2. Adhere Layer 2 to centered on the card base.

Adhere the Lemon Lime Twist cardstock cut for Layer 3 to the basic black accent piece also cut for Layer 3. Adhere Layer 3 to Layer 2 by centering top to bottom and then off the left-side of Layer 2 about  $\frac{1}{4}$ ".

For Layer 4, I used the Stampin' Up! 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " and the 2  $\frac{3}{4}$ " Layering Circles Framelits dies for the Whisper White circle and the black accent piece. Stamp one of the flowers from the Flower Shop stamp set in Lemon Lime Twist centered on the Whisper White circle and then stamp one of the sentiments from the All Things Thanks stamp set in basic black archival ink directly on top of the flower. Adhere the two circles together and then adhere Layer 4 a bit off center on Layer 3.



### Inside of card:

On the bottom, right-hand corner of the Whisper White cardstock cut for the inside of the card, stamp in Lemon Lime Twist the same flower that was used to create the background paper on Layer 2 and adhere to the inside of the card.



### Envelope:

Place the 8" x 8" piece of Whisper White cardstock on the envelope punchboard and line up the paper with the 3 1/2" mark on the left side. Use the scoring tool and score along the line on the punchboard on the right, then push the button on the back of the device to cut out a notch. Turn the paper counterclockwise and line up the score line with the pointed arrow at the front of the notch button; score along the line on the punchboard on the right and then press the notch button; turn the paper counterclockwise and match up the score line; repeat. You will score and punch a total of 4 times. Once you've completed scoring and punching, fold on score lines towards the bumpy-side of the score line; apply adhesive to form the envelope. Once the envelope is formed, take the same flower stamp you use to create the background paper and stamp randomly on the envelope flap and on the front on the bottom left corner.
