Now we will enter into a new relationship as I have been asked to serve as your Interim Pastor, until a new Pastor is called and installed at Prince of Peace.

Of course, there will be changes in the schedule from the pattern maintained by Pastor Seth, but I will do my very best to provide the ministry services expected by the congregation. Officially, I will be a part-time Pastor, and will be working in the office 1.5 to 2 days per week. I will also be making calls and visiting during the week and leading worship on Saturdays and Sundays.

I will keep Monday as my "official" day off (as Pastor Seth did) and I will be as flexible as I can in scheduling to meet your needs. I rely on your prayers and support as this new stage in our congregational life begins. If you see something that needs attention, or if you have a concern, please come directly to me. Together we can keep Prince of Peace on the positive trajectory it has enjoyed under Pastor Seth's guidance. It is a time of adjustments but also an exciting time as we consider the future of our ministry and the Pastor we hope to call. I pray we will thrive in this time together!

MEALS ON WHEELS




