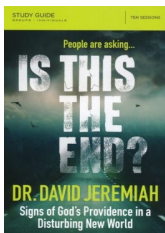


There will be a brief Going Solo meeting in the Fellowship Hall, immediately following today's service.

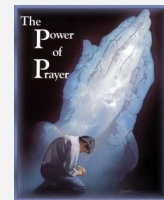
