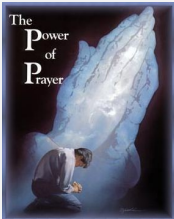
UM Men's Breakfast is held the third Saturday of each month in the Fellowship Hall at 9:00 a.m. All men are invited.
