Member of the governing body: A person who serves on an organization's governing body, including a director or trustee, but not if the person lacks voting power.

Director or trustee: A member of the organization's governing body at any time during the tax year, but only if the member has any voting rights. A member of an advisory board that does not exercise any governance authority over the organization is not considered a director or frustee.

Officer: A person elected or appointed to manage the organization's daily operations at any time during the tax year, such as a president, vice-president, secretary, treasurer, and, in some cases, Board Chair. Voting Member/Independent Voting Member: A member of the organization's governing body with power to vote on all matters that may come before the governing body (other than a conflict of interest that disqualifies the member from voting). An Independent Voting Member is a member of the governing body with voting power is considered "independent" only if the member, or any family member of the member, was not compensated as an officer or employee by the organization, or by a related organization, or by an independent contractor of the organization.

Related organization: An organization, including a nonprofit organization, a stock corporation, a partnership or limited liability company, a trust, and a governmental unit or other government entity, that stands in one or more of the following relationships to the filing organization at any time during the tax year. 1) Parent: an organization that controls the filing organization; 2) Subsidiary: an organization controlled by the filing organization; 3) Brother/Sister: an organization controlled by the same person or persons that control the filing organization; 4) Supporting/Supported: an organization that is organized and operated exclusively to support the filing organization.

Independent contractor: An organization that has a business relationship with the organization but is not a Related Organization.
