§ 36-1. Provision of police service. ¹

The Township of Colebrookdale shall provide to the Borough of Bechtelsville twenty-four-hour-per-day, seven-day-per-week, police coverage of the same scope and quality as is provided by the township to its own residents. The Borough of Bechtelsville shall pay to the township an annual agreed-upon fee for the police coverage to be provided to it.

§ 36-2. Implementation of agreement.

The Borough of Bechtelsville shall enter into a written agreement with the Township of Colebrookdale to detail the agreement between themselves relating to the provision of police services and the organization of a police committee to be established to oversee the operation of the Colebrookdale Township Police Department.

§ 36-3. Disposition of fines. ²

Fines generated by citations issued or complaints filed by the Colebrookdale Township Police Department shall be paid by the District Justice of the local District Court to the municipality in which the offense giving rise to the citation or the complaint occurred.
