

2019-2020 ACCHS Enrichment Day Class Descriptions/Costs Classes September 17- November 19

Pre-K

Storytime

A time to read to pre-K age students and give them an environment that encourages them to love reading! Class will run approximately 30 minutes.

ABC Art

Fun class to help pre-k children learn the alphabet. Children will do a craft or art project each week to learn a new letter. Class will run approximately 30 minutes.

Emergent Readers

For pre-readers to gain a better foundation in reading using fun, activity-centered projects that will teach phonics, decoding and sight words just to name a few. Class will run approximately 30 minutes.

Sing-A-Long

Introducing songs to encourage singing together.

K-3

Gym

Fun high-energy activities that will increase well-being, expend energy, as well as encourage hand-eye coordination, following directions, good sportsmanship and team work.

Choir (grades 1-6)

Fun scripture verse songs, as well as patch the pirate children's songs.

Fifty States Facts Class – Cost \$5.00 per student

This class has been designed to teach children about the 50 states and their capitals, as well as teach some fact facts about each state. There will not be homework as children will be doing everything in class. Five states will be covered per class. The \$5.00 fee is used to cover copying costs for activity pages, etc.

Gym - \$5.00 ("uniform" shirt)

Focus on soccer skills. Great for those who play soccer and those who wish to simply enjoy team building and physical fitness.

Industrial Art – cost \$37.00 (two projects)

Build both a wooden candy dispenser and catapult!

Board Games –cost \$2.00

In this class, everything will be all fun and games! We will play many different types of games, exploring the different mechanics used in modern board games. Many of these games secretly reinforce learning – just don't tell the students that!

4-6 Continued:

Ohio History – cost is \$20.00 per student

Cost includes booklet, binder and binder supplies. Children will need colored pencils, glue sticks, scissors and pencil bag. We will explore Ohio History through reading, discussion and hands-on activities. This class will meet the state requirement for Ohio History.

Choir

Fun scripture verse songs, as well as patch the pirate children's songs.

Apologia Science –Cost will be book (purchased individually) as well as lab expenses. Apologia Exploring Creation with Human anatomy and Physiology: Students will need to read the chapter on their own before class (there is an audio book available if needed). Outlines with key points to study will be passed out, but the main focus of the Eday class will be doing experiments, discussing the chapter, and reviewing.

Karate – Cost (1st semester is \$5.00 for new families and or replacement book. 2nd semester is \$5.00 for boards.) During Karate class we will work on our coordination, confidence, focus, and discipline through many different techniques. We will work on kicks and punches, katas, self-defense, sparring, and flow drills.

7-12

Drama – Cost \$20.00 per student

Parts will be assigned and a play will be performed in December, 2019. Students must be comfortable in front of a large audience, as well as be able to memorize material fairly quickly. Students wishing non-speaking parts will be accommodated as the play allows.

Government (Bob Jones; 3rd Edition) (One Elective Credit/Cultural Philosophy) Book supplied by student
Class will discuss the American system of government. There will be an election carried out by the students. They will learn about writing their own platforms and how the electoral college works. The class will have unit tests as well as a final. The tests will consist of multiple choice questions and 1 essay question. The textbook used will be *American Government* by Bob Jones Press, 3rd Edition.

Bible Theology – Cost \$10

This class will discuss a Christian Worldview. There will be a test at the midpoint of the class and at the end. The students will discuss a biblical worldview in 10 different areas. The student will receive the notes for the class. In order to offset the cost of copying for the handouts there will be a \$10 fee for the class.

Board Games – cost \$2.00

In this class, everything will be all fun and games! We will play many different types of games, exploring the different mechanics used in modern board games. Many of these games secretly reinforce learning – just don't tell the students that!

Geography – cost TBD (1 credit)

This class will explore geography terminology, map work, US geography, world geography and more through the use of hands on activities, games and weekly homework (including research and mapping assignments). We will also have a potluck lunch once or twice during the year with each student sharing a food from a different location of the world.

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
