

2019-2020 ACCHS Enrichment Day Class Descriptions/Costs Spring Classes January 28 – March 31

K-3

Gym

Fun high-energy activities that will increase well-being, expend energy, as well as encourage hand-eye coordination, following directions, good sportsmanship and team work.

Choir (grades 1-6)

Fun scripture verse songs, as well as patch the pirate children's songs.

Enriched Reading

This will be a fun class where the kids will be assigned a week to bring their favorite book in to be read. We will then discuss the book as a group. i.e. their favorite part, character, reason why it's their favorite book etc. We will also have books available to read. Our objectives are to get excited about reading and develop comprehension of what has just been read.

All about Animals – Cost \$5.00 per student

The spring session will be "All About Animals" We will read picture books and use lap booking to study different animals throughout the year such as bats, desert animals, frogs etc. Children will need crayons or colored pencils, scissors, and a glue stick. Cost is \$5 for file folders, and cost of printing.

Gym -

Team building and physical fitness.

Industrial Art – cost \$35.00

This session will focus on three dimensional artwork. Each student will create a number of pieces using materials such as paper, wood, wire and clay. Students will learn about various artists and styles.

Board Games –cost \$2.00

In this class, everything will be all fun and games! We will play many different types of games, exploring the different mechanics used in modern board games. Many of these games secretly reinforce learning – just don't tell the students that!

Ohio History – No cost for continuing students

Cost includes booklet, binder and binder supplies. Children will need colored pencils, glue sticks, scissors and pencil bag. We will explore Ohio History through reading, discussion and hands-on activities. This class will meet the state requirement for Ohio History.

Choir

Fun scripture verse songs, as well as patch the pirate children's songs.

Apologia Science –Cost will be book (purchased individually) as well as lab expenses. Apologia Exploring Creation with Human anatomy and Physiology: Students will need to read the chapter on their own before class (there is an audio book available if needed). Outlines with key points to study will be

passed out, but the main focus of the Eday class will be doing experiments, discussing the chapter, and reviewing.

Karate – Cost (1st semester is \$5.00 for new families and or replacement book. 2nd semester is \$5.00 for boards.) During Karate class we will work on our coordination, confidence, focus, and discipline through many different techniques. We will work on kicks and punches, katas, self-defense, sparring, and flow drills. (ONLY THE 1:00 PM CLASS CAN ACCEPT NEW STUDENTS FOR THE SPRING SEMESTER)

7-12

Drama – Cost \$10.00 per student

Scene study includes working on scenes from published plays and screenplays to learn basic concepts of approaching a scene. Movement focus on breaking down inhibitions, building ensemble spirit, and providing the necessary tools to bring physical dimension to all of his or her roles. Voice: students gain insight into the power of their voices and learn how to nurture and control their voices by exercising various resonators and muscles.

Government (Bob Jones; 3rd Edition) (One Elective Credit/Cultural Philosophy) Book supplied by student Class will discuss the American system of government. There will be an election carried out by the students. They will learn about writing their own platforms and how the electoral college works. The class will have unit tests as well as a final. The tests will consist of multiple choice questions and 1 essay question. The textbook used will be *American Government* by Bob Jones Press, 3rd Edition.

Bible Theology – No cost for continuing students

This class will discuss a Christian Worldview. There will be a test at the midpoint of the class and at the end. The students will discuss a biblical worldview in 10 different areas. The student will receive the notes for the class. In order to offset the cost of copying for the handouts there will be a \$10 fee for the class.

Board Games – cost \$2.00

In this class, everything will be all fun and games! We will play many different types of games, exploring the different mechanics used in modern board games. Many of these games secretly reinforce learning – just don't tell the students that!

Geography – cost TBD (1 credit)

This class will explore geography terminology, map work, US geography, world geography and more through the use of hands on activities, games and weekly homework (including research and mapping assignments). We will also have a potluck lunch once or twice during the year with each student sharing a food from a different location of the world.

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
