The Daily Office

A notable difference between the The Spanish-Language Prayer Book and the English-Language Book of Common Prayer is that, unlike the English-Language Book of Common Prayer, the Spanish-Language Prayer Book does not contain two sets of the Daily Office: Rite I and Rite II. Instead the Spanish Prayer Book contains one set of each of the Daily Offices which use formal language, mostly still in common usage and with a Latin American style. Each service is organized by office not by Rite. As such the Daily Office are found in order of Daily use as Follows:

Collects

A second notable difference between the English-Language Prayer Book and its Spanish-Language equivalent is the absence of two sets of collects in the latter. The distinction between the traditional and contemporary forms of the second person pronoun and possessive in English, namely you and thee as well as your and thy, is the primary difference between the traditional and contemporary collects. This does not exist in Spanish since equivalent forms of both are still in common usage. Instead, the distinction in Spanish is one of formality and familiarity. Consequently, an appropriate editorial choice was made by the translators of the Spanish prayer book to retain a degree of formality while opting for familiarity with respect to God. Any attempt to copy the traditional and contemporary forms of the Collects, that the English-Language Prayer book contains, would serve no functional purpose and create needless confusion. For this reason the Spanish prayer book contains only one set of collects usable for both Rite I and Rite II services.

A third notable difference between the Book of Common Prayer and the Spanish-Language version is the absence of two sets of Burial rites. The Spanish Prayer Book contains one Burial Rite which combines both the Rite I and Rite II options of the English prayer book and uses formal language, mostly still in common usage, with a Latin American style.
