## » ROSE BOWL STADIUM

There are no in-and-out privileges at the Rose Bowl Stadium. Once you exit the stadium, you may not re-enter.

### STADIUM ENTRY GATES

There are eight (8) stadium entry gates that service the Rose Bowl Stadium: "A" through "G" and "N" (North). Your game ticket allows access through any gate.

### BAG POLICY

The Rose Bowl Stadium has implemented a clear bag policy for all events at the Rose Bowl Stadium. We encourage fans to conform to the policy prior to arriving at the Rose Bowl Stadium. Otherwise large purses and bags must be returned to vehicle or checked in for a fee of \$10 at one of the stadium's item check-in tents.

### APPROVED BAGS

- » 12" x 6" x 12" Clear Plastic Bag
- » 1 Gallon Plastic Freezer Bag
- » Clutch with Shoulder Strap (clutch may not be larger than 4.5" X 6.5")
- » Clutch with Wrist Strap (clutch may not be larger than 4.5" X 6.5")
- » Diaper Bag, as long as accompanied by a child

### PROHIBITED BAGS

- » Backpacks
- » Camera Case
- » Mesh Bag
- » Purse
- » Clear Backpack
- » Tinted Plastic Bag
- » Oversized Tote Bag
- » Printed Pattern Plastic Bag
- » Fanny Pack
- » Binoculars Case

## SECURITY MEASURES

In order to provide a safe environment for fans, the following security measures may be in effect:

Searches at the entry gates will include inspection of all items that are carried into the stadium. Patrons may be subject to metal detectors, wand searches or full searches of your person, also known as "pat downs." Searches may cause delays in entering the stadium. Please give yourself plenty of time to allow for entry into the stadium.

Law enforcement personnel may conduct inspections of vehicles parking near the stadium.

If you see something suspicious on your way to the game or at the stadium, please report it immediately to local law enforcement or call 9-1-1.


## PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following items are NOT permitted to be brought into the Rose Bowl Stadium:

- » Animals
- » Bags that violate the Bag Policy (See Bag Policy)
- » Balls, toys or sports equipment
- » Banners, signs, flags, poles or sticks
- » Beverage containers larger than 17 oz. (Factory sealed plastic bottles of water, 17 oz. or less, are allowed; limit 2 per person)
- » Boxes or wrapped packages
- » Cans, glass bottles or alcoholic beverages
- » Coolers
- » Drones
- » Glass, metal or hard plastic containers
- » Helium balloons
- » Laser pointers
- » Noisemakers including thunder sticks, musical instruments, whistles, air horns and boom boxes
- » Outside Food (only for non-UCLA games)
- » Skates, skateboards, hoverboards, scooters or bicycles
- » Umbrellas
- » Unauthorized cameras with lenses longer than 3.5 inches, interchangeable or telephoto lenses
- » Unauthorized video cameras, monopods, tripods or selfie sticks
- » Weapons or projectiles

### Note:

Strollers are welcome but not allowed to be stored in an aisle or under a seat. Strollers may be checked in at the following Guest Services Location - Tunnel 18 or at the Checked Items Tent located at Gate C.

## Terms & Conditions

### RESERVATIONS

Reservations may be made online above or by calling (405) 364-7500 or (800) 781-2244. All reservations will be acknowledged with a confirmation on a first-come, first-served basis.

### PAYMENTS

Payment Schedule:

A non-refundable deposit of \$450 per person is required to reserve space.

Final Payment: Due by July 25, 2019.

Reservations received on or after July 25, 2019 will be on a space available basis and will require payment in full at the time of booking.

Payment may be made with a credit card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover) or personal check.

If paying by check, please indicate what travel package you are interested, make the check payable to Oklahoma Tickets and mail to either: 2215 W Lindsey St, Suite 200, Norman, OK 73069. All credit cards will be processed by Collegiate Athletic Travel.

### CHANGES, CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

A fee of \$50 per change will be assessed for any revision made to a reservation. If flight changes (including flight cancellations) are requested, revision fees or airline cancellation fees will apply.

No refunds will be issued for cancellations unless the participant's airline and/or hotel space is resold. If space is resold, participant will receive a refund, less the non-refundable deposit, plus any airline name change fees that result from the resale. Refunds shall not be given for unused travel services or any portion thereof. If cancellation by one or more travelers alters the room requirements of the remaining travelers, those still traveling may be required to pay a revised rate.

We regret that we cannot make exceptions for personal emergencies. We request that you consider purchasing travel protection. Exceptions to this policy cannot be made for any reason, including weather, acts of God, terrorism, civil unrest, personal or medical emergencies.

### TRAVEL INSURANCE

Due to the dollar amount of our packages, we strongly recommend the purchase of appropriate insurance coverage.

Trip cancellation, baggage loss, health and accident insurance is available upon request to protect participants against unforeseen circumstances that may cause interruption or cancellation of trip as well as loss of property. Medical insurance policies may not protect your travels away from home and often have out-of-network deductibles. Likewise, coverage through credit cards can have shortfalls and not fully protect you.

### HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

Traveler agrees to be responsible for all incidental charges incurred in excess of those covered by the package. Incidental charges can include food, beverages, telephone use, internet use, parking fees, and other hotel charges. All hotels require a credit card or deposit for incidental charges at time of check-in. Hotels expect departing guests to vacate rooms by the posted check-out time and arriving guests to check-in later than the posted check-in time. Most hotels do their best to minimize inconvenience and store luggage if one chooses to arrive early or depart late. Accommodations are subject to availability. Oklahoma Tickets/Collegiate Athletic Travel reserve the right to substitute confirmed hotels with comparable bedding accommodations at either their own or the hotel's discretion.

### ROLL-AWAYS

Roll-aways may only be added to king-bedded rooms and will incur extra charges. Requests for roll-aways are subject to availability and differing fire and safety laws.

### GAME TICKETS

Game tickets are NOT included in the travel packages. Should you need assistance in obtaining tickets, we will be glad to provide options to you.

### SPECIAL CHILDREN'S PRICING

Children's rates are limited to those 12 years of age or under sharing a room with at least one adult and using existing bedding configuration (i.e., if 2 adults and a child/children occupy a room, the adults will be charged the double price and the children the child's price. If the room is occupied by 1 adult and a child/children, the adult will be charged the single price and the children the child's price.)

### DOCUMENTATION & PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION

It is the responsibility of each individual traveler to obtain the documentation required for their trip such as passports, visas, birth certificates and photo identification.

### HEALTH, DISABILITY & SPECIAL NEEDS

Travelers should be in good overall health in order to fully appreciate their trip. Travelers should also be able to walk moderate distances at a steady pace and navigate uneven surfaces. If you have concerns about your ability to participate in a Oklahoma Tickets / Collegiate Athletic Travel trip, we strongly urge you to consult your personal physician prior to your departure. Please advise Oklahoma Tickets of any physical limitations that may affect your ability to travel.
