Traffic shift to allow for work on the southbound lanes of M-24 in Oxford; one lane still open for southbound traffic

COUNTY:

PROJECT DETAILS:

Beginning Friday, August 21st, southbound traffic will be shifted onto the new northbound pavement between Burdick St. and just north of Drahner Rd in Oxford. This will allow crews to begin construction on the southbound lanes. This configuration will extend north to Gateway Dr. once all northbound work is complete and will be in place until late fall.

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is investing \$33 million to reconstruct and resurface parts of M-24 in Oakland County. The project limits along M-24 are between Goldengate Street in Orion Township to Harriet Street in Oxford Township, with the villages of Oxford and Lake Orion also being affected.

DETOUR:

There is NO detour route for this phase of this traffic switch, as a single lane of southbound traffic will always be maintained.

Extending the center left-turn lanes, improving the pavement surface, adjusting lane widths, and consolidating driveways will increase motorist safety by reducing the number of crashes in this area.
