## Elementary Track & Bible Day

### Event Rules and Regulations

#### Field Events--Ribbons for 1<sup>st</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> place or participation given for each event.

1. **Running Long Jump** - each contestant will have three attempts to jump the longest distance. Measurement will be made from the take-off line to landing point. Boys and girls will compete separately.
2. **Dashes** - K-3 will run the 50-meter dash while 4-7 graders will run the 100-meter dash. Fastest time wins. Boys and girls will compete separately. There will be a fun run for the pre-k students.
3. **Softball Throw** - best of three throws for the farthest distance wins. Boys and girls will compete separately.

#### Bible Events - Ribbons for Superior, Excellent or participation given for each event.

1. **Bible Trivia** - Questions will be asked on Old and New Testament information. The student will receive a superior, excellent, or participant ribbon depending on the number of correct responses. This is a written test. The test is read by the instructor in grades kindergarten through second.
2. **Scripture Memory** - Students will recite verses with references. Although we only sent out verses in the ESV version, you may use the ESV, NIV or KJV (listeners will have those versions available) for memory work (or bring your Bible along). Superior, excellent, or participant ribbons will be awarded to each student depending on number of helps needed or mistakes made.
3. **Bible Spelling** - A traditional oral spelling bee with many Biblical words. It is important to remember that the *students must pronounce the word, spell the word correctly, and pronounce the word again* for it to be correct. The student cannot start over once they have started spelling the word. Kindergarten will spell the *word on paper* as it is drawn from a hat.

#### Activity Regulations

1. Students are asked to stay with their grade groups. A group leader will escort groups from one location to the next. Free time will be spent outside or in the gymnasium pending weather conditions.
2. Parents are encouraged to enjoy watching their children participate in the events. Non school-aged children must be supervised at all times. Older students (8<sup>th</sup> grade and up) are welcome to help with events – please contact the coordinator if interested.
3. All ribbons will be awarded at the end of the closing ceremonies.
4. Lunch Break - either you may bring your own sack lunch, or students and adults may purchase a hot lunch for \$5.00 (PLEASE PURCHASE AT REGISTRATION OR OPENING CEREMONIES) — there is no charge for ages 4 and under. Feel free to join us in the cafeteria with your sack lunch.
