May BOM - bring to May Meeting

*Woven Ribbons

Blue & White

Materials

1/8 yard each of 3 Coordinating prints for Rail Fence Blocks (One should be a white on white or cream on cream,

Cutting

From each of the three prints, cut 2 strips $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 40"$ (if using fat quarters, cut 4 strips)

Block Assembly

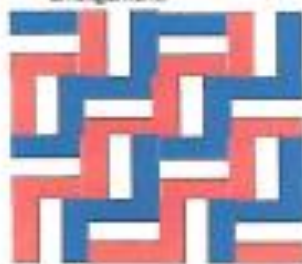
Finished Size 5"

1. Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}"$ wide strip to each long edge of the white or cream strip.
2. Use a Ruler & Rotary Cutter to clean cut the edges of strip sets. Cut a total of 16 blocks, each $3\frac{1}{2}"$ wide.



Pillow Assembly

1. Arrange the Rail Fence Blocks. There are several ways they can be arranged. Below are 2 diagrams of possible arrangement.



Finished block will be $12\frac{1}{2}"$

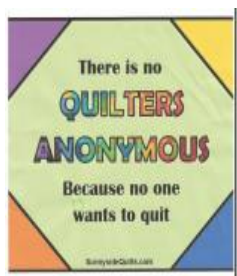
Hospice of the Chesapeake
