



Appendix II

PURPOSES OF THE TRUST

- Arranging for the preparation and delivery of food parcels to people in need of food as a result of a disaster event or others notified to the trust as in need by local community groups, groups, charitable trusts, local council and medical professionals affecting the North Canterbury or any other community in New Zealand.
- Donating basic life essentials such as food, shelter and clothing to people in need of such items as a result of a disaster event or otherwise affecting the North Canterbury or any other community in New Zealand.
- Establishing and operating a distribution and delivery network of gifts, food and parcels for the purposes of making provision to people in need of such a network due to the effects of a disaster event or otherwise affecting the North Canterbury or any other community in New Zealand.
- To provide bequests, gifts and donations for comforts for the elderly, sick, poverty stricken persons, and any other individuals within the North Canterbury or any other community in New Zealand at a time when such people are limited financially as a result of a disaster event or otherwise.
- Providing Christmas gifts, vouchers or goods to people in need within the North Canterbury or any other community in New Zealand affected by a disaster event or otherwise in time of need.
- For promoting charitable programs for children or people who would benefit from such programs within the North Canterbury or any other community in New Zealand due to the effects of a disaster event or otherwise.
- Generally to promote the interests and well-being of the people within the North Canterbury or any other community in New Zealand regardless of race, creed, religion, sex or any other such categorisation and to endeavour to assist them with the quality of life by whatever means when such people are in need of social, mental, physical and or emotional rehabilitation due to the effects of a disaster or otherwise.
- To assist with providing for recreation or leisure time occupation for people within the North Canterbury or any other community in New Zealand to promote social cohesion, provide social rehabilitation and relieve poverty to people who have been adversely affected by a disaster event or otherwise.
- Generally assisting people and communities in need of help or assistance as advised to the trust through community networks, charitable groups, medical professionals, local body groups or individuals as the trustees consider appropriate.
