Recital - Location & Date:

The P.A.C.E. Studio's annual recital will take place at Milton High School Auditorium on Saturday, June 6th, at 6:00 PM. Tech and Dress Rehearsal will take place at Milton High School Auditorium on Friday, June 5th, at 2:00 PM (dancer attendance is mandatory). A *Recital Information Packet* will be sent home with students in early April. The Recital Information Packet will contain rules and procedures for recital day, calendar of events, and recital order forms for flowers, Blu-Ray recordings of recital, Recital T-shirts, Souvenir Medals, etc.

Recital Theme:
