Thank you to all for any donation given so far in this calendar year of 2018!! Your gifts to Christ Our Rock Lutheran High School are much appreciated by our student body and staff! If successful, this campaign drive will take the place of all other operating fund appeals each year. By meeting the goal proposed in this donation drive, our operating budget for educating the 100-140 students the Lord will entrust to CORLHS will be met every year. Our goal for this year is \$360,000 raised. This donation need arises from the gap between the cost of educating a student, \$9,000, and the tuition charged per student. Class of 2022 fee is \$5,800.
