TRACKING TEST AWARD

A wooden initial will be given to each handler & dog team that passes the Tracking Dog test.

IMPORTANT NOTES TO EXHIBITORS

CERTIFICATION; With the entry form for a dog that has not passed an AKC Tracking Test, there must be filed an original statement dated within one year & signed by a person who has been approved by the American Kennel Club to judge tracking tests (or Provisional Tracking Judge), or has had a title within the past 10 years certifying that the dog is considered ready for such a test.

TEST LIMIT & DRAW: This test is limited to 3 TD, 3 TDX dogs. Entries will remain open until WEDNESDAY, 02/26/2020 until 5:00 p.m. If entries received exceed the test limit, a public drawing will be held WEDNESDAY, 02/26/2020, at 6:00 p.m. at BSKD, 2980 W. Oxford Ave, Sheridan, Colorado. Any interested parties may attend. Acknowledgment will be mailed to all entrants as soon as practicable. If alternate entries remain after the draw, an additional draw will be conducted to determine the order in which alternates will run. In all cases, preference will be given to Pembroke Welsh Corgis first, followed by all other breeds. If limits for entries are not reached in 1 test area & entries are exceeded in another, the number of tracks may be exchanged at the ratio of 2 TDs for 1 TDX, etc.

ENTRY FEE: \$75.00 – TD; \$125.00 (in US dollars) TDX. (This includes the 50 cent AKC recording fee & the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee.) Make checks **payable to PWCCR** & send, with TD certification, to the Event Secretary, Ms. Lynn Kaemmerer, 1 Glenridge Dr., Littleton, CO. 80123

ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is withdrawn from the test after the closing date, absent, disqualified, excused by judges or barred from competition by the test committee, unless an alternate exhibitor is available & willing to take the spot of the exhibitor. If, because of storms or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete this event, no refund of entry fees will be made, except as allowed in the Tracking Regs, Chapter 1, Section 11. Cancellation of entries must be made in writing or e-mail to the Test Secretary & must be received by the Secretary prior to the closing date. Entries sent by **OVERNIGHT DELIVERY** must be marked “no signature required”.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE under the conditions stated in the AKC Tracking Regs, Chapter 2, Section 8.

USE THE OFFICIAL AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB ENTRY FORM & write "Tracking" in the "Obedience Trial Class" space. Telegraphed, telephoned, unsigned, conditional or incomplete entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form & photocopies of forms without the Agreement & Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

THE ORDER OF RUNNING will be determined by a draw for tracks at the time called for on the face of this premium list.

PWCCR does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry forms for these events.

RISK: The owner or agent entering a dog in a Tracking Test does so at his/her own risk & agrees to abide by all of the Rules & Regulations of the American Kennel Club. The PWCCR assumes no responsibility for any personal injury or death of any person, theft of personal property, theft, injury, or death of any animal or loss of or damage to any property while at this test or on the test site, or in transit to or from the site.

IMPORTANT NOTICES REGARDING OUR TEST SITES: Exhibitors are requested to not practice at the test sites within three days of the test without first contacting the test chairperson to find out which areas may be used. **Exhibitors & spectators are not permitted to park along the Chatfield Park roads.** This is a park rule! Designated drivers will take exhibitors & spectators to drop-off or viewing points. Dogs owned or under the control of any persons associated with the Tracking Test must be **ON LEAD** at all times. Please pick up after your dog. A Park Entry Fee is required to enter Chatfield Park – the exhibitor is responsible for paying this fee. Chatfield Park is a heavily used state park and exhibitors can expect to encounter horses, bicycles, pedestrians, and wildlife such as deer, elk, coyotes, foxes, bull snakes, prairie dogs and rattlesnakes. Walking in to and out of tracks may be required.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (std, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim & Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, std).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered & shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record & dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.
