Additionally, we are open for business and very thankful to have you as a part of the Crate Escape Atlanta family.

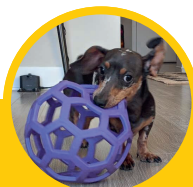

Is there a COVID-19 vaccine for dogs and cats?

There is no vaccine for COVID-19 for people or animals at this time. Veterinarians are familiar with other coronaviruses. Similar but different coronavirus species cause several common diseases in domestic animals.



Many dogs, for example, are vaccinated for another species of coronavirus (Canine Coronavirus) as puppies. However, this vaccine does not cross protect for COVID-19.

We will be using "STRATIS" app to enter / exit your home when possible, limiting the surface areas we come in contact with while in your home and communities.
