Course Outline

This course provides advanced training for law enforcement officers to develop criminal interdiction and investigations relating to hotel/motel, parcel freight, self-storage, vehicle rental facilities, and commercial motor vehicle initiatives.

The goal of this course is to provide the law enforcement officer and their respective police departments with time tested and cutting edge investigative tactics. The instruction exemplifies a unified front for aggressively tackling the problems and potential threats associated to drug & weapons trafficking, organized crime & smuggling networks, and international terrorism. By identifying the conduits and criminal indicators which organized crime and terror operatives exploit, law enforcement officers will be able to better develop and cultivate intelligence information, confidential informants and investigative avenues to better facilitate and support their efforts. The law enforcement officer will understand the importance of developing channels of communication to build partnerships within certain private sector industries which are known to be exploited by criminal organizations, smuggling networks and terror operatives. Additionally, the law enforcement officer will develop a skill set of "**best practices and methods**" to identify criminal indicators, trends, and tactics to enhance investigations and arrests

Instructors

Captain (retired) Robert "Bob" Gaugler is a highly decorated police officer who has over 28 years of law enforcement experience. Bob enlisted as a "Trooper" in 1986, and rose through the ranks of the New Jersey State Police, retiring as the Regional Commander of the Narcotics & Organized Crime Bureaus. As a veteran in law enforcement, Captain Gaugler possesses extensive executive leadership and supervisory experience in conducting large scale criminal investigations. Bob provides expertise in criminal interdiction, undercover narcotics, violent gang crime suppression, intelligence development, confidential informant cultivation, homeland security enhancement measures, community policing, and numerous innovative law enforcement practices and procedures. Bob has instructed at the International Law Enforcement Academy for the U.S. State Department - Bureau of International Narcotics and Law Enforcement Affairs, on the topics of Transnational Organized Crime, Terrorism and Anti-Corruption. Captain Gaugler possesses a proven history of successful partnerships with other law enforcement agencies, jurisdictions, and personnel throughout the United States and abroad. Bob is a graduate of the FBI National Academy Executive Leadership School (Session 249), and holds a Master's Degree in Professional Education as well as a Bachelor's of Science in Business Administration from Seton Hall University.

Lieutenant (retired) Glenn "Luber" Lubertazzi is a highly decorated 25 year veteran of the New Jersey State Police. Glenn enlisted as a "Trooper" in 1987, and was assigned to the New Jersey State Police Field Operations Section in northern New Jersey to conduct highway patrol related duties. While assigned to highway patrol, Glenn developed an innate ability for highway criminal interdiction and making felony arrests. His criminal interdiction investigations were instrumental in making several of the largest drug and currency seizures within the State of New Jersey. Glenn also served as the New York/New Jersey HIDTA Task Force Deputy Commander, where he was responsible for the supervision of various large scale criminal investigations involving the Mexican and Colombian Cartels. Glenn has provided training and instruction throughout the United States to various law enforcement academies and jurisdictions. Glenn holds a Master's Degree in Professional Education from Seton Hall University as well as a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Business Administration from Glassboro State College.
