January 1st

January 10th

1 Chronicles 4:10 - A prayer of increase (Jabez's Prayer) Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, "Oh that you would bless me indeed, and enlarge my border,

and that your hand might be with me, and that you would keep me from evil, that it not be to my sorrow!" (WEB) **AMEN**

January 11th

Hebrews 4:14-16 - Strengthen the women who are struggling in their faith or with temptation!

Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has gone through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet was without sin. January 23rd

Psalm 62:5-7 - Give them hope and rest! Find rest, O my soul, in God alone; my hope comes from him. He alone is my rock and my salvation; he is my fortress, I will not be shaken. My salvation and my honor depend on God; he is my mighty rock, my refuge. **AMEN!**

January 24th

Psalm 51:10-12 - Restore their joy! Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me. **AMEN!**

January 25th

Psalm 18:2 - Give the women a restored relationship Almighty God, I pray that I will be taken into a deeper, more meaningful relationship with You, where I will grow in faith and hear the still small voice within my soul. Help me to be attentive to Your call, that will cause me to walk in Your righteousness. Open the eyes of my heart. January 26th

January 27th

Psalm 63:1-5 - As women seek You, may they find complete fulfillment in their relationship with You! O God, You are my God, earnestly I seek You; my soul thirsts for you, my body longs for You, in a dry and weary land where there is no water. I have seen You in the sanctuary and beheld Your power and your glory.

Because Your love is better than life, my lips will glorify You. I will praise you as long as I live, and in your name I will lift up my hands. My soul will be satisfied as with the richest of foods; with singing lips my mouth will praise You. In Jesus name. **Amen.**

January 28th

James 5:13-16 - Lord, encourage the women to ask for prayer! Heal the sick in body, soul, and mind! Is any one of you in trouble? [She] should pray. Is anyone happy? Let [her] sing songs of praise. Is any one of you sick? [She] should call the elders of the church to pray over [her] and anoint [her] with oil in the name of the Lord. Therefore, confess your sins to each other, and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous [woman] is powerful, and effective. In Jesus name. Amen!

January 29th

Philippians 1:9-11 - Give the women discernment that flows from a heart of love! And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless until the day of Christ, filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God. January 30th

Colossians 3:15 - Lord, make me an instrument of your peace: where there is hatred, let me sow love where there is injury, pardon; where there is doubt, faith; where there is despair, hope; where there is darkness, light; where there is sadness, joy. **AMEN!**

January 31st
