Treasurer Report (handout only- Becky McKeever not present to give report):

Ending balance as of 11/20/19=\$16,082.97

Deposits and Credits from 11/19 to 01/28= \$29,247.69

Cleared and Uncleared Debits from 11/20 to 01/20= \$31,072.63

Balance as of 1/28/20= \$14,258.03

Holding aside \$1000 in anticipation of costs associated with Munster's Got Talent show.

Charms accounts credits (allocated to individual students)= \$5,815.32

Donations allocated for trailer/tubas= \$10,918.70

Cash flow currently available for spending= **-\$3,475.99 (yes, that is a negative number)**

Currently we still have over \$6,000 IN UNPAID/OVERDUE BAND FEES!! THIS IS UNACCEPTABLE.

- Please check your CHARMS accounts and PAY YOUR FEES! Payment Due letters were sent out via mail.
- Unpaid fees could result in ineligibility to participate in winter percussion/winter guard, and marching band jackets will not be returned to individual students until fees are paid.
- Band/Guard fees are NOT INCLUDED in school fees that are collected at the time of registration in the fall.
- If you do not know how to get into your CHARMS account to check your balance, email Becky M. ASAP!
- If you have credits from FRIP, Butter Braid Sales, Mattress sale, etc, THESE CREDITS DO NOT AUTOMATICALLY TRANSFER to cover your balance. If your amount due is greater than the amount of credit you have in your account, the balance of the account must be paid as well in order for the credits to transfer. **If you have any questions, please email Becky M.**
