### THE UPWARD BOUND PROGRAM

The Upward Bound Program at Mississippi Valley State University is comprised of two components. The Summer Year Component (SY) is a six weeks' session where students live on campus to get a feel of college life.

The Academic Year component is made up of twenty Saturdays, and students are enrolled in three academic classes that they are currently enrolled in at their high schools.

The Upward Bound Programs at Mississippi Valley State University provides services for 165 ninth through twelfth grade students from Holmes, Humphreys, Leflore, and Sunflower Counties. The Upward Bound Project is funded by the U.S. Department of Education.
