



## AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB AGILITY COURSE TEST

**Sunday, 26, 2019**  
**TWO Trials – Same Day**

Earn an agility title on your beginner dog in a trial atmosphere! The Agility Course Test is an entry level agility event to introduce beginning dogs and/or handlers to the sport of agility. Dogs must be 15 months old to enter and must meet the requirements for a regular agility trial (Chapter 1, Section 3), except that they need not be AKC registered to enter.

**ACT Level 1** is open to all dogs who have not earned any AKC titles. The course will have 10-12 obstacles including a 5' AFrame, table, tunnel, bar jumps (no spreads). Tire and panel jump are allowed but not required. Time for the course will be 60 seconds and a score of 85 is required.

**ACT Level 2** is open to all dogs who have not earned any AKC titles except for an ACT1 title. The course will have 11-13 obstacles. All Level 1 obstacles will be used with the addition of a teeter, tire, 1 spread and 6 weaves. Time for the course will be 70 seconds and a score of 85 is required.

**Refusals and Run outs** are not judged. More than 3 attempts will result in an elimination/failure to perform. Table faults, Wrong courses and Failures to Perform will be judged as in a regular agility class. Two passing scores are needed for a title and can be under the same judge.

**Jump Heights** are at the handlers discretion. Jump Heights are 4,8,12,16,20 inches. A jump height card and measuring are not required.

**Entry fee** - TKC club member \$ 12.00 (including \$5 AKC recording fee) per run  
Non club member \$ 15.00 (including \$5 AKC recording fee) per run

Day of show entries will be taken if limit has not been reached between 12 noon and 1 pm.

**Entry Limit** is 30 runs per trial. Closing date for pre entry is the day before the trial.

**Check in** 12 noon and 1 pm. Briefing will be at 1pm followed by a 5 minute walk thru. Judging will follow walk through. Tall to small in each class  
Plenty of indoor crating. Heated and/or AC. Rubber flooring. Rubber contacts.

**Judging Schedule** ACT 1 – Trial 1 followed by ACT 1 – Trial 2 followed by ACT 2 – Trial 1 followed by ACT 2 – Trial 2.

If your dog has done well in the ACT1 and you would like to try the ACT2, we will add your ACT2 entry if limit has not been reached.

**Awards** –Qualifying ribbons, placement double flat ribbons, and title ribbons available.

**Dogs that are not registered with AKC** are eligible to participate and their performance will be recorded by AKC under a temporary recording number. This will be emailed to you and must be used when entering any subsequent ACT events. You cannot use that for any other AKC events except for the ACT events

**Entries will be accepted as received.** Your entry must be complete and signed or will not be accepted. No phone, email or fax entries will be accepted. Express entries must include a signature waiver allowing them to be accepted without a required signature. Returned checks will no constitute a valid entry and a \$30 charge will be collected in addition to the entry fee. There will be no refunds if your dog is absent, excused or barred from competition. Refunds will be given for bitches in season upon inspection or a letter from a veterinarian.

No dogs are allowed off leash except when in the ring and only enter the ring when the dog before you is out of



AGREEMENT

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events.

In order to acquire the ACT1 or ACT2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club. AKC Canine PartnersSM applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results.

Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
