Jobs, duh

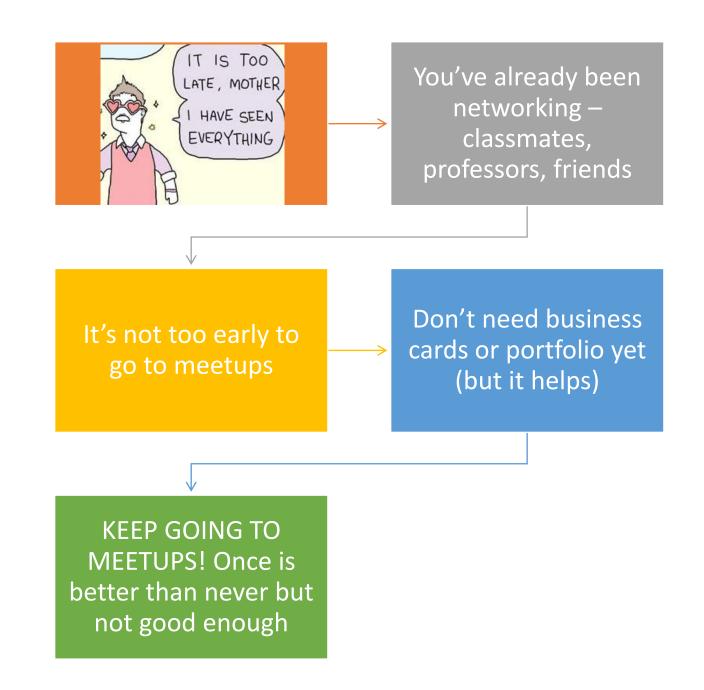
Friends ask friends for help

Schedule meetings with specific date and time

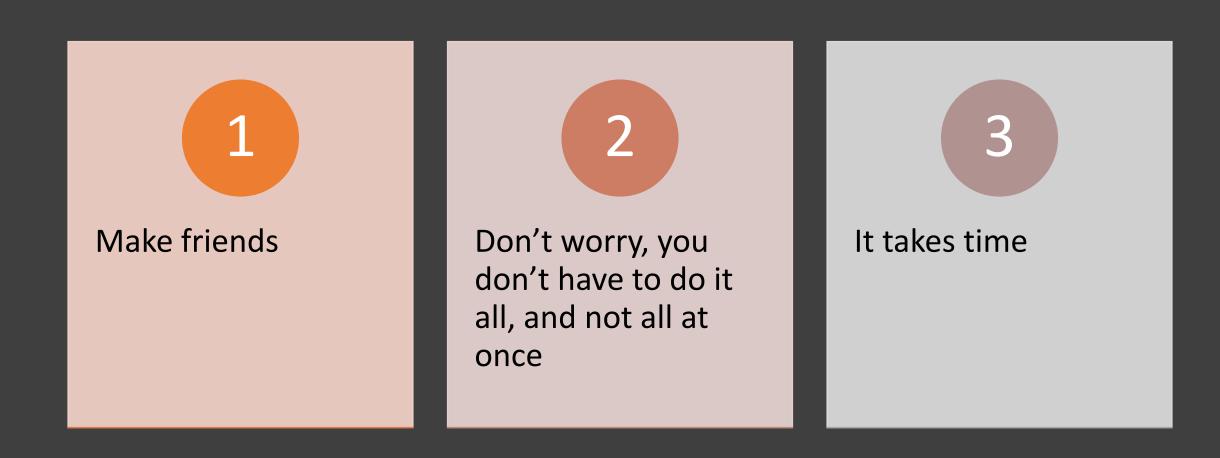
