Boat trip on Inle Lake, local market, Phaung Daw U pagoda, Innpawkone village, floating gardens, sunset shoot with local fishermen

19

Sunrise photo shoot with local fishermen, boat trip on Inle Lake, Samkar village, pottery village, sunset shoot with local fishermen

Drive to Heho airport, fly to Kyaing Tong, Wat Zon Kham temple, Maha Myat Muni temple and/or Wat Inn Temple, sunset photo shoot at Naung Tong Lake

4x4 drive to Pin Tauk village of Ann Eng Tribe, picnic lunch, Wan Pauk village
