

Ron Collier Collegiate Scholarship Program for New Palestine High School Seniors

Official Rules:

These Official Scholarship Rules are specific to the Indiana Members Foundation Ron Collier (Collier) Collegiate Scholarship Program. By applying for this collegiate scholarship, each student applicant agrees to be bound by the Official Scholarship Rules.

Applicant Eligibility

Each applicant must:

- Be an Indiana Members Credit Union (IMCU) member in good standing with his/her IMCU account opening date no less than six months prior to the time of application.
- Be a Senior at New Palestine High School, New Palestine, Indiana
- Be intending to study full-time (minimum of twelve (12) credit hours) at an accredited college or university in a two or four year undergraduate degree program, for the fall semester.
- Have a weighted cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.

NOTE: IMCU employees and IMCU employee's relatives are not eligible for the Collier.

Scholarships Awarded

There will be one (1) \$2,500 scholarship paid for a total of \$2,500 in scholarships.

Dollar amounts available for scholarships may change on an annual basis, based on the financial commitment available from Ron Collier and the Indiana Members Foundation.

Applying for the Scholarship:

Applications will be accepted annually from January 1 thru February 15, 2020. Complete and submit the online scholarship application form, found on the website www.imf4kids.org starting January 1, 2020.

Submit the requested supporting documents listed below.

Supporting Documents:

Documents required for submission include:

- Most recent official Copy of New Palestine High School grades (including cumulative GPA)
- A copy of college or university acceptance letter,
- Signed Scholarship Release, Permission & Consent Form.



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Selection of Scholarship Recipients

Scholarship recipients will be awarded based on the quality of the student's application, work experience, extracurricular activities, and future ambitions.

The scholarship applications will be reviewed and final decisions will be made by the Collier Selection Committee at Indiana Members Credit Union.

Announcing the Winners

The scholarship winners will be contacted directly by phone and/or email. Once all recipients have been notified their names will be published on the Indiana Members Foundation website www.imf4kids.org. The Collier Scholarships will be announced in a formal press release and awarded at the annual New Palestine awards banquet.

Disbursement of Scholarships

- A check for the proceeds will be issued directly to the community college or university.
- Students must show proof that they are registered for at least twelve (12) credits during the Fall semester.
- The funds may be used for any educational related expenses provided these expenses can be paid directly through the financial aid office.
