Volunteers will be given duties that match their interests, abilities and learning goals as time, resources and library needs allow.

Adult volunteers must:

1. Complete a short survey.
2. Be available in 2-4 hour increments when the Director is in the office.
3. Report all hours directly to the Director.

Adults with compulsory service hours must see the Library Director.

By signing below, volunteers agree:

- That they are at least 14 years old or in the 8th grade
- To be respectful to and cooperative with other volunteers, library staff and library patrons
- To ask questions when unsure of duties
- To fulfill duties to the best of their ability
- To remain in public areas unless accompanied by a staff member
- To refrain from disruptive behavior
- To be a positive presence in the library
- To a background check
