## Rocks Fossils and Volcanos @ Ray County Library

We started this program making fossils. These need a little time to harden.

#### Materials:

Cooking spray like Pam

**Plaster of Paris** 

Play dough

Water

Shells and Rocks

Directions:

Flatten out a ball of playdough. Then make an impression in the playdough with a sea shell. Remove the shell and spray the play dough lightly with cooking spray. Add water to the plaster of paris and pour into the mold. Allow to harden.







Next we made some igneous rocks. Make igneous rocks that you can eat! Yum These needed to melt in the oven. It took about 30 minutes at 200 degrees. http://preschoolpowolpackets.blogspot.com/2016/04/edible-igneous-rocks-model-science.html

## Igneous Rocks!! Model & Experiment


### **Directions:**

Have the children add the ingredients and mix them up like the Earth would mix up rocks. On Earth rocks get moved around by wind, water, and crust motion.


The candy and crackers represented rocks and sand and the marshmallows represented minerals like quartz!

These are just a few we have at Ray County Library.




While our fossils hardened and our igneous rocks melted and cooled I read this book.




This you tube video has an excellent demonstration for making sedimentary, metamorphic and igneous rocks with starburst.

Finally you have metamorphic rock.
